- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact four new sections to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the creation of the North Dakota commission on higher education
- 3 funding; to provide an expiration date; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 6 and enacted as follows: 7 North Dakota commission on higher education funding - Membership. 8 The North Dakota commission on higher education funding consists of: 9 1. The governor or an individual designated by the governor, who shall serve as the 10 chairman; 11 The commissioner of higher education or the commissioner's designee; b. 12 Two members of the state board of higher education, selected by the state board; <u>C.</u> 13 The vice president for finance and administration at North Dakota state university <u>d.</u> 14 or the vice president's designee; 15 The vice president for finance and operations at the university of North Dakota or <u>e.</u> 16 the vice president's designee: 17
 - One individual, appointed by the governor, who is employed as the business f. manager or the vice president for finance at a two-year institution under the control of the state board of higher education;
 - One individual, appointed by the governor, who is employed as the business g. manager or the vice president for finance at any institution under the control of the state board of higher education other than an institution represented under subdivision d, e, or f;
 - The chairman of the senate education committee or the chairman's designee: h.

10		I.	One legislator appointed by the majority leader of the house of representatives;

12	<u>2.</u>	The	following nonvoting members:			
13		<u>a.</u>	One individual appointed by the chairman of the legislative management from a			
14			list of three names submitted by the North Dakota council of college faculties;			
15			<u>and</u>			
16		<u>b.</u>	One individual appointed by the chairman of the legislative management from a			
17			list of three names submitted by the North Dakota student association.			
18	SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created					
19	and enacted as follows:					
20	<u>Nor</u>	th Da	akota commission on higher education funding - Rules of operation and			
21	procedure.					
22	<u>1.</u>	The	North Dakota commission on higher education funding shall establish its own			
23		<u>duti</u>	es and rules of operation and procedure, including rules relating to appointments,			
24	ı	tern	ns of office, vacancies, quorums, and meetings, provided that the duties and the			
25		<u>rule</u>	s do not conflict with this Act.			
26	2.	Not	withstanding subsection 1, in order for a motion to be adopted by the commission,			
27		othe	er than a motion pertaining solely to procedural matters:			
28		a.	The motion must be consented to by any seven of the thirteen commission			
29			members; and			
30		b.	Three of the five legislators serving on the commission must be on the prevailing			
31			side.			

1	SECTION 3. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created					
2	and enacted as follows:					
3	<u>Nor</u>	North Dakota commission on higher education funding - Compensation and				
4	reimbur	sement.				
5	<u>1.</u>	Members of the North Dakota commission on higher education funding are entitled to				
6		reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the same manner as				
7		state officials.				
8	<u>2.</u>	In addition, members of the legislative assembly who serve on the commission and				
9		the individual who is the owner or manager of a business located in this state are				
10		entitled to receive per diem compensation, in the amount provided for in section				
11		54-03-20, if they are attending meetings or performing duties directed by the				
12		commission.				
13	<u>3.</u>	The commissioner of higher education shall use up to forty thousand dollars from				
14		moneys appropriated in the system governance line item in the appropriation bill for				
15		the North Dakota university system office, as approved by the legislative assembly, to				
16		provide the compensation and reimbursements required by this section.				
17	SEC	TION 4. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created				
18	and ena	cted as follows:				
19	<u>Nor</u>	orth Dakota commission on higher education funding - Duties - Reports.				
20	<u>1.</u>	In order to ensure the continued delivery and financing of a quality system of higher				
21		education in this state, the North Dakota commission on higher education funding shall				
22		examine alternative methods for funding higher education, including any funding				
23		method that is developed by the state board of higher education or others and which				
24		will reward:				
25		a. Specifically identified outcomes such as:				
26		(1) Increases in the number of degrees awarded;				
27		(2) Increases in the number of on-time graduations;				
28		(3) The number of degrees awarded to low-income students; and				
29		(4) Increases in the number of students retained beyond their first year; and				
30		b. Any other outcome considered desirable by the commission.				
31	<u>2.</u>	The North Dakota commission on higher education funding may:				

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1	<u>a.</u>	Examine a funding methodology that is based on the actual cost of delivering a
2		quality education to the various cost categories of enrolled students, as
3		determined by the commission, including online students, students whose
4		programs require laboratory access, and graduate students, as well as any other
5		categories of students;
6	<u>b.</u>	Develop a system of weighted student costs, one of which could include the size
7		of the educating institution; and
8	<u>C.</u>	Assume that historic spending levels are the initial indicator of the actual cost of
9		educating students.
10	3. The	e North Dakota commission on higher education funding shall provide reports to the
11	<u>leg</u>	slative management and the state board of higher education during the 2011-12
12	inte	erim and the 2013-14 interim.
13	SECTIO	N 5. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through December 31, 2014, and
14	after that dat	e is ineffective.
15	SECTIO	N 6. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
