- 5 INCENTIVE GRANT PROGRAM INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION. During the 2011-13 biennium,
- 6 the industrial commission shall establish and administer a program to provide a grant to a
- 7 qualified applicant for the purpose of assisting the applicant with the costs associated with
- 8 acquiring or constructing facilities for, and operating, a demonstration plant to determine the
- 9 technological and economic attributes of producing transportation biofuel from multiple sugar
- 10 based feedstock. A grant awarded under this program may not exceed \$7,000,000.
- 11 **SECTION 2. CONTINGENT APPROPRIATION.** Subject to the industrial commission
- 12 certifying to the office of management and budget that an applicant has qualified for a grant,
- there is appropriated out of any moneys in the resources trust fund in the state treasury, not
- otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$7,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to
- the industrial commission for the purpose of providing a sugar-based feedstock biofuel
- demonstration plant incentive grant in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of this Act, for
- the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
