- 1 A concurrent resolution recognizing the 25th anniversary of the formation of North Dakota's
- 2 sister state relationship with the Province of Taiwan, Republic of China.
- WHEREAS, North Dakota has enjoyed a sister state relationship with Taiwan since April 3,
- 4 1986; and
- 5 **WHEREAS**, the people of this state and of Taiwan have enjoyed a long history of friendly
- 6 relations and increased international understanding and have benefited from growing
- 7 commercial and educational interaction between North Dakota and Taiwan; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in 2009 North Dakota-exported goods to Taiwan were valued at nearly
- 9 \$4 billion; and
- WHEREAS, over the last 20 years, the University of North Dakota has educated more than
- 11 250 pilots from Taiwan; and
- WHEREAS, North Dakota has long-standing partnerships with Taiwan, including both states
- 13 hosting visiting public and private sector representatives to facilitate trade;
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
- 15 NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- That the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly takes pride in recognizing the 25th anniversary
- 17 of the formation of North Dakota's sister state relationship with Taiwan and looks forward to this
- 18 relationship continuing for years to come; and
- 19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this resolution
- 20 to the President of Taiwan, the Governor of North Dakota, the Speaker of the Taiwan Provincial
- 21 Consultative Council, the Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in Kansas City, Missouri, and the
- 22 Executive Director of the North Dakota Trade Office.
