- A concurrent resolution urging Congress to repeal the Patient Protection and Affordable Care
  Act.
- 3 **WHEREAS**, the United States Congress passed and the President signed into law the
- 4 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act on March 23, 2010; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, as amended by the Health
- 6 Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010, comprises comprehensive federal health care
- 7 reform legislation, which is commonly referred to as the Affordable Care Act; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the law will increase taxes on employers who do not offer adequate insurance
- 9 and will increase taxes on investment income, which in turn will reduce capital available for job
- 10 expansion, reduce economic growth, and result in fewer jobs for Americans; and
- 11 **WHEREAS**, the provisions of the law will add to the national debt; and
- WHEREAS, the United States Congress has a number of bills before it which would repeal
- 13 the law, including the "Repealing the Job-Killing Health Care Law Act";
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
- 15 NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- That the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly urges Congress to repeal the Patient Protection
- 17 and Affordable Care Act; and
- 18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this resolution
- 19 to each member of the North Dakota Congressional Delegation.
