**ENGROSSED HOUSE CONCURRENT  
RESOLUTION NO. 3030**

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study the feasibility and  
2 desirability of requiring use of cigarette tax stamps.

3 **WHEREAS**, North Dakota is one of only three states that do not require tax stamps on  
4 cigarettes; and

5 **WHEREAS**, a study of the feasibility and desirability of requiring tax stamping on cigarettes  
6 will allow consideration of the benefits and detriments of requiring cigarette tax stamps on the  
7 state, wholesalers, the public, and administrative and law enforcement agencies;

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**  
9 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

10 That the Legislative Management study the feasibility and desirability of requiring use of  
11 cigarette tax stamps; and

12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and  
13 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to  
14 the Sixty-third Legislative Assembly.
