

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4023

1 A concurrent resolution urging the Legislative Management to study transportation safety for
2 minors.

3 **WHEREAS**, the safety of the children of this state is of high concern, especially when
4 traveling as part of child care and school activities; and

5 **WHEREAS**, certain vehicles, for example buses and vans, have different safety features
6 and dangers, for example, some buses do not have seat belt and high back seats; and

7 **WHEREAS**, children of different ages have different safety needs and require different
8 safety devices; and

9 **WHEREAS**, providing the safest vehicle with the best equipment for every child should be
10 the concern of every child care facility and school;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
12 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the Legislative Management study transportation safety for minors;

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
15 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
16 the Sixty-third Legislative Assembly.
