STATEMENT OF INTENT

4 This measure removes the current prohibition on the governor expressing the governor's intent

5 to use the governor's veto power.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

- 7 SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 8 That the following proposed amendment to section 10 of article V of the Constitution of
- 9 North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the
- 10 general election to be held in 2012, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the
- 11 Constitution of North Dakota.

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 10 of article V of the Constitution of North Dakota is
amended and reenacted as follows:

14 Section 10. A governor who asks, receives, or agrees to receive any bribe upon any

15 understanding that the governor's official opinion, judgment, or action shall be influenced

16 thereby, or who gives or offers, or promises the governor's official influence in consideration that

17 any member of the legislative assembly shall give the member's official vote or influence on any

18 particular side of any question or matter upon which the member may be required to act in the

19 member's official capacity, or who menaces any member by the threatened use of the-

20 governor's veto power, or who offers or promises any member that the governor will appoint any

21 particular person or persons to any office created or thereafter to be created, in consideration

that any member shall give the member's official vote or influence on any matter pending or

thereafter to be introduced into either house of the legislative assembly, or who threatens any

24 member that the governor will remove any person or persons from office or position with intent

in any manner to influence the action of that member, must be punished in the manner now, or

- 1 that may hereafter be, provided by law, and upon conviction thereof forfeits all right to hold or
- 2 exercise any office of trust or honor in this state.
