HOUSE BILL NO. 1063

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsections 1 and 2 of section 43-04-42 of the North
2 Dakota Century Code, relating to barber licensing fees.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsections 1 and 2 of section 43-04-42 of the North Dakota
5 Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:

6 1. The board may charge applicants the following fees:

7 a. For examination and issuance of a certificate to practice master barbering, one
8 hundred dollars.

9 b. For examination and issuance of a certificate to practice as an apprentice barber,
10 fifty dollars.

11 c. For renewal of a master barber's certificate, ~~fifty~~one hundred dollars.

12 d. For restoration of an expired master barber's certificate, a ~~ten~~twenty dollar
13 penalty fee in addition to the regular renewal fee.

14 e. For renewal of an apprentice barber's certificate, twenty dollars.

15 f. For restoration of an expired apprentice barber's certificate, a ~~ten~~twenty dollar
16 penalty fee in addition to the regular renewal fee.

17 g. For a permit to operate a barber school or college, an annual fee of one hundred
18 twenty-five dollars.

19 h. For issuance of an annual barbershop license, ~~thirty-five~~fifty dollars, to be paid by
20 each shopowner in advance.

21 i. For issuance of a certificate to an applicant who qualifies under section
22 43-04-38.1, one hundred ~~twenty-five~~seventy-five dollars.

23 j. For restoration of an expired barbershop license, a ~~ten~~twenty dollar penalty fee in
24 addition to the annual license fee.

- 1 k. For renewal of an instructor's license, twenty-five dollars.
- 2 2. Each application to open or establish a barbershop in this state must be accompanied
- 3 by a fee of ~~forty~~one hundred dollars to cover expenses of inspection, which must be
- 4 retained by the board and deposited as other fees.
