- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 12-60-24 and
- 2 a new section to chapter 43-47 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to criminal history
- 3 record checks of counselors; and to amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 43-47-03 of the
- 4 North Dakota Century Code, relating to fees.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 SECTION 1. A new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 12-60-24 of the North Dakota
- 7 Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 8 The board of counselor examiners for applicants for licensure or licensees under
- 9 <u>chapter 43-47, except that criminal history record checks for licensees need not</u>
 10 be made unless required by the board.

11 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of section 43-47-03 of the North Dakota Century

- 12 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- Set, by rule, and collect a fee, not to exceed one hundred fifty dollars, for the filing of
 each application for a license under this chapter and set, by rule, and collect a fee, not
- 15 to exceed one hundred dollars, for the renewal of a license under this chapter.

16 **SECTION 3.** A new section to chapter 43-47 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

17 and enacted as follows:

18 Criminal history record checks.

19 The board shall require an applicant for licensure under subsections 2, 3, and 4 of section

20 <u>43-47-06 and section 43-47-06.1 to submit to a statewide and nationwide criminal history record</u>

- 21 check and may require a licensee to submit to a statewide and nationwide criminal history
- 22 record check. The nationwide criminal history record check must be conducted in the manner
- 23 provided in section 12-60-24. All costs associated with obtaining a background check are the
- 24 responsibility of the applicant or licensee.
