**SENATE BILL NO. 2066**

1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 24-17-02 and a new  
2 subsection to section 24-17-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to political signs.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 24-17-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 created and enacted as follows:

6 "Political sign" means a temporary sign erected on private property, which includes  
7 signs which solicit votes or support for, or in opposition to, any candidate or any  
8 political party under whose designation any candidate is seeking nomination or  
9 election. Political signs may also contain messages concerning any public question on  
10 the ballot in an election held under the laws of the state. Political signs do not include  
11 signs which have been issued a legal billboard permit by a city, county, or the state of  
12 North Dakota.

13 **SECTION 2.** A new subsection to section 24-17-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
14 created and enacted as follows:

15 Political signs temporarily installed on private property, providing the signs do not  
16 include any form of commercial advertising.
