- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 50-11.1-07.8 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to suspension of license, self-declaration, or registration document involving a child
- 3 abuse and neglect investigation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 50-11.1-07.8 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 50-11.1-07.8. Suspension of license, self-declaration, or registration document -

8 Notification to parent.

- 9 1. The department may suspend a license, self-declaration, or registration document
 10 during an investigation of upon a report of child abuse or neglect at the premises of the
 11 licensed program, holder of the self-declaration, or registration, or of involving a staff
 12 member if continued operation would jeopardize the health and safety of the children
 13 present.
- 14 2. <u>The department may suspend a license, self-declaration, or registration document if</u>
- 15 an operator, holder of a self-declaration, registrant, or household member of an
- 16 <u>individual providing early childhood services within the individual's home has been</u>
- 17 <u>charged with an offense that has a direct bearing on the individual's ability to serve the</u>
- 18 public as a licensee, a holder of a self-declaration, or a registrant, or if a minor child in
- 19 the household is brought before the juvenile court because of a deprivation, unruly, or
- 20 <u>delinquent incident involving an offense that has a direct bearing on the individual's</u>
- 21 <u>ability to serve the public as a licensee, a holder of a self-declaration, or a registrant.</u>
- 3. Notwithstanding sections 50-11.1-07 and 50-25.1-11, the department shall notify the
 parent of any child receiving early childhood services when that program's license,
- 24 self-declaration, or registration document is suspended.

- 1 <u>3.4.</u> Upon the conclusion and disposition of the investigation of the program, the
- 2 department shall notify the parent of each child receiving early childhood services of3 the disposition.
- 4 <u>5.</u> Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, a suspension under this section may
- 5 preclude an individual's ability to operate pending an appeal.
