1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact subsection 3 to section 4.1-47-05 and subdivision c to 2 subsection 1 of section 4.1-47-31 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the process by 3 which the noxious weed list is amended and the penalty for selling noxious weeds; to amend 4 and reenact section 4.1-47-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the control and 5 sale of noxious weeds; to provide a penalty; and to allow the agriculture commissioner to use 6 environment and rangeland protection funds for invasive species control. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 8 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-47-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is 9 amended and reenacted as follows: 10 4.1-47-02. Control of noxious weeds - Responsibility. 11 Each person shall do all things necessary and proper to control the spread of noxious 1. 12 weeds. 13 2. No person may distribute, sell, or offer for sale within this state a noxious weed. 14 **SECTION 2.** Subsection 3 to section 4.1-47-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 15 created and enacted as follows: 16 3. In adding or removing weeds from the noxious weed list the commissioner is not 17 required to comply with rulemaking requirements in chapter 28-32. 18 **SECTION 2.** Subdivision c to subsection 1 of section 4.1-47-31 of the North Dakota Century 19 Code is created and enacted as follows: 20 C. <u>A person who violates subsection 2 of section 4.1-47-02 is subject to a civil</u> 21 penalty not to exceed one hundred dollars for each violation. 22 SECTION 3. ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION FUND - INVASIVE 23 SPECIES CONTROL.
