- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the judicial branch;
- 2 and to amend and reenact sections 27-02-02 and 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to salaries of supreme and district court judges.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
other income, to the judicial branch for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency,
for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

26	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There are appropriated any funds received by the			
27	supreme court, district courts, and judicial conduct commission and disciplinary board, not			
28	otherwise appropriated, pursuant to federal acts and private gifts, grants, and donations for the			
29	purpose as designated in the federal acts or private gifts, grants, and donations for the period			
30	beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.			

1	SECTION 3. TRANSFERS. The director of the office of management and budget and the		
2	state treasurer shall make such transfer of funds between line items of appropriation for the		
3	judicial branch of government as may be requested by the supreme court upon a finding by the		
4	court that the nature of the duties of the court and its staff requires the transfers to carry on		
5	properly the functions of the judicial branch of government.		
6	SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 27-02-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
7	amended and reenacted as follows:		
8	27-02-02. Salaries of justices of supreme court.		
9	The annual salary of each justice of the supreme court is one hundred twenty-fourthirty-four		
10	thousand twenty-sevenone hundred thirty-five dollars through June 30, 20102012, and one		
11	hundred thirtythirty-eight thousand twoone hundred twenty-eightfifty-nine dollars thereafter. The		
12	chief justice of the supreme court is entitled to receive an additional three thousand fiveeight		
13	hundred sixty-twofifty-two dollars per annum through June 30, 20102012, and three thousand		
14	sevennine hundred fortysixty-eight dollars per annum thereafter.		
15	SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
16	amended and reenacted as follows:		
17	27-05-03. Salaries and expenses of district judges.		
18	The annual salary of each district judge is one hundred thirteentwenty-two thousand sixnine		
19	hundred forty-eightten dollars through June 30, 20102012, and one hundred nineteentwenty-six		
20	thousand three five hundred thirtyninety-seven dollars thereafter. Each district judge is entitled to		
21	travel expenses, including mileage and subsistence while engaged in the discharge of official		
22	duties outside the city in which the judge's chambers are located. The salary and expenses are		
23	payable monthly in the manner provided by law. A presiding judge of a judicial district is entitled		
24	to receive an additional three thousand twofive hundred eighty-twofifty dollars per annum		
25	through June 30, 2010 2012, and three thousand foursix hundred forty-seven fifty-seven dollars		
26	thereafter.		
27	SECTION 6. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO		
28	SIXTY-THIRD LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time funding		
29	items approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly for the 2009-11 biennium and the 2011-13
