1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of

2 corrections and rehabilitation; to provide for a legislative management studyan appropriation to

3 <u>the office of management and budget;</u> to provide for a report to the budget section; and to

4 provide legislative intent.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 7 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 8 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 9 other income, to the department of corrections and rehabilitation for the purpose of defraying 10 the expenses of the department of corrections and rehabilitation, for the biennium beginning 11 July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

1 SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO

SIXTY-THIRD LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time funding
items approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly for the 2009-11 biennium and the 2011-13

15 2013-15 biennium. The department of corrections and rehabilitation shall report to the

appropriations committees of the sixty-third legislative assembly on the use of this one-time

17 | funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - TRANSFER - STATE PENITENTIARY LAND FUND.

There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,100,000, which the office of management and budget shall transfer from the general fund to the state penitentiary land fund on July 1, 2011, for the purpose of providing funding for the prison expansion project.

23 SECTION 4. DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION - HOUSING

24 **CONTRACT.** The department of corrections and rehabilitation shall contract with an

25 organization to house women inmates sentenced to the department for the biennium beginning

- July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, at a rate that equals the actual costs incurred by the
- 27 organization for providing the housing services. If, at the conclusion of the 2011-13 biennium,
- 28 the agreed-upon contract amount differs from the actual expenditures of the organization for the
- 29 biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, the organization shall disclose and
- 30 report the variance to the department of corrections and rehabilitation.

2	TREATMENT SERVICES PAYMENTS. The department of corrections and rehabilitation shall-
3	distribute in twenty-four equal payments the sum of \$1,677,723 from the general fund
4	appropriated in the adult services line item in section 1 of this Act to the heart of America
5	correctional and treatment center for inmate-related treatment services, for the biennium
6	beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. If the heart of America correctional and
7	treatment center does not accept a sufficient number of inmates to occupy at least ninety-six-
8	percent of the average daily treatment program bed count provided for in the contract for the-
9	first ten months of each year of the biennium, the department of corrections and rehabilitation
10	shall reduce the monthly payments for the remaining two months of each year. The total
11	reduction for the two months is the sum of the monthly calculation of the number of beds at
12	ninety-six percent occupancy less the number of beds filled multiplied by the daily rate-
13	multiplied by the number of days in the month. The department of corrections and rehabilitation
14	shall refer a sufficient number of inmates to the heart of America correctional and treatment
15	center to allow for the average daily treatment program bed count provided for in the contract to
16	be fulfilled for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
17	SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY. During the 2011-12 interim, the
18	legislative management shall consider studying the Missouri River correctional center, including-
19	the feasibility and desirability of the Missouri River correctional center relocating adjacent to the
20	state penitentiary. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations,
21	together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-third-
22	legislative assembly.
23	SECTION 5. REPORT TO BUDGET SECTION. The department of corrections and
24	rehabilitation shall, during the 2011-12 interim, report quarterly to the budget section regarding
25	the progress of the prison expansion project.
26	SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - NEW FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS. It is
27	the intent of the sixty-second legislative assembly that the department of corrections and
28	rehabilitation not fill any of the forty-nineforty-seven new full-time equivalent positions for the
29	state penitentiary expansion project prior to ninety days before the estimated completion date of
30	the project.
