1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the

2 adjutant general; to provide appropriations; to provide for transfers; to provide exemptions; to

3 create and enact a new section to chapter 37-17.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating

4 <u>to written confirmation of federal disaster funding;</u> to amend and reenact section 37-17.3-08 of

5 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to state radio fees; to provide legislative intent; and to

6 declare an emergency.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 9 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 10 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 11 other income, to the office of the adjutant general for the purpose of defraying the expenses of 12 that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows: 13 Subdivision 1.

The adjutant general shall report to the appropriations committees of the 5 sixty-third legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning 6 July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. 7 SECTION 3. VETERANS' CEMETERY MAINTENANCE FUND - APPROPRIATION. In 8 addition to the amount appropriated to the adjutant general in the veterans' cemetery line item 9 in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, there is appropriated any additional funds which are 10 received and deposited in the veterans' cemetery maintenance fund pursuant to sections 11 37-03-14 and 39-04-10.10 for the operation of the North Dakota veterans' cemetery for the 12 biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. 13 SECTION 4. STATE DISASTER RELIEF FUND - APPROPRIATION. In addition to the 14 amount appropriated to the adjutant general in subdivision 2 of section 1 of this Act, there is 15 appropriated, subject to emergency commission approval, any additional fundsout of any 16 moneys in the state disaster relief fund, as determined necessary by not otherwise appropriated, 17 the sum of \$3,500,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the adjutant general for 18 the purpose of providing the required state share of funding to match federal funds for defraying 19 the expenses of associated with presidential-declared state disasters pursuant to section 20 37-17.1-27. 21 SECTION 5. MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS - TRANSFERS. The adjutant general may 22 transfer to the operating expenses and capital assets line items contained in section 1 of this 23 Act up to the sum of \$500,000 from the various other line items contained in section 1 of this 24 Act, as determined necessary by the adjutant general to provide for the maintenance and repair 25 of state-owned armories in this state during the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending 26 June 30, 2013. Any amounts transferred pursuant to this section must be reported to the 27 director of the office of management and budget. 28 SECTION 6. EXEMPTION. Any amounts carried over pursuant to section 3 of chapter 312 29 of the 2009 Session Laws that is unexpended as of June 30, 2011, is not subject to section 30 54-44.1-11 and is available for payment of adjusted compensation to veterans. Any unexpended

1	funds from this appropriation must be transferred to the veterans' cemetery trust fund during		
2	the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.		
3	SECTION 7. EXEMPTION. The amount appropriated in the capital assets line for the next		
4	generation 911 study and state radio tower study in section 1, subdivision 2, of chapter 16 of the		
5	2009 Session Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds from this		
6	line item are available for conducting these studies during the biennium beginning July 1, 2011,		
7	and ending June 30, 2013.		
8	SECTION 8. A new section to chapter 37-17.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created		
9	and enacted as follows:		
10	Written confirmation of federal disaster funding required.		
11	If the expected source of funding or reimbursement for a construction or repair project is		
12	from or through the approval of the federal emergency management agency, a political		
13	subdivision shall request and receive written approval from the federal emergency management		
14	agency before contracting for the construction or repair.		
15	SECTION 9. AMENDMENT. Section 37-17.3-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
16	amended and reenacted as follows:		
17	37-17.3-08. State radio system and service fees.		
18	<u>1.</u> The director shall establish the appropriate fees for access to the state radio system		
19	and the service provided to local government users of the mobile data terminal system		
20	and North Dakota law enforcement telecommunications systems and other such		
21	systems that may be employed that enhance public safety. Changes to fees charged		
22	by the division, including schedule of charges for counties and cities, will take effect on		
23	July first. The director shall announce any fee increases a minimum of one year prior-		
24	tobefore the effective date. When the director considers an adjustment, as a part of		
25	the process the director shall consult with representatives of state and local units of		
26	government prior tobefore setting fees. The director may consider economic		
27	conditions and the general economy when setting fees. The director shall deposit all		
28	revenue obtained under this chapter with the state treasurer for deposit in the state		
29	radio broadcasting system operating account. The state radio broadcasting system		
30	operating account must be expended pursuant to legislative appropriation for the		
31	operation and maintenance of the system. Fee structures will include:

12		be l	evied on a per terminal basis. State general fund agencies that access the system	
13		will	not incur any fees for the service. City and county law enforcement fees will be	
14		based on the following schedule of charges per terminal:

17		b.	County population of five thousand or more but less than ten thousand shall pay	
18			sixtyeighty dollars per month.	
19		C.	County population of ten thousand or more but less than fifteen thousand shall	
20			pay ninety<u>one hundred twenty</u> dollars per month.	
21		d.	County population of fifteen thousand or more but less than twenty-five thousand	
22			shall pay one hundred twentysixty dollars per month.	
23		e.	County population of twenty-five thousand or more shall pay onetwo hundred	
24			sixty dollars per month.
