- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 61-28 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to exemptions from enforcement actions for water-to-water transfers
- 3 used to control flooding; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 61-28 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

6 and enacted as follows:

7 <u>Water-to-water transfers used to control flooding exempt.</u>

- 8 <u>1.</u> An action may not be brought under either chapter 32-40 or 61-28 against an owner or
 9 operator of a water-to-water transfer used to control flooding for violation of the state's
 10 water pollution control laws if the water-to-water transfer:
- 11 <u>a.</u> <u>Does not require a national pollutant discharge elimination system permit; and</u>
- b. Complies with the conditions in the state's water quality standards established to
 protect aquatic life.
- 14 <u>2.</u> For purposes of this section, "water-to-water transfer" means an activity that conveys
- 15 or connects waters of the United States without subjecting the transferred water to
- 16 <u>intervening industrial, municipal, or commercial use. This section does not apply to</u>
- 17 pollutants introduced by the water transfer activity itself to the water being transferred.
- 18 <u>3.</u> <u>The owner or operator of a water-to-water transfer falling within this exemption must</u>
- 19 <u>notify the department before beginning operations.</u>
- 20 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
