A BILL-for an Act to amend and reenact section 12.1-10-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
relating to disobedience of a judicial order; and to declare an emergency.for an Act to create
and enact a new subsection to section 29-06-15 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to
arrests without a warrant; and to declare an emergency.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 12.1-10-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows: 8 12.1-10-05. Disobedience of judicial order. 9 A personAn individual is guilty of a class A misdemeanor if the personindividual 10 disobeys or resists a lawful temporary restraining order or preliminary or final-11 injunction or other final order, other than for the payment of money, of a court of this 12 state. 13 Notwithstanding the limitations of section 12.1-32-01, the defendantindividual may be 14 sentenced to pay a fine in any amount deemed just by the court. 15 An individual who willfully violates a lawful order of a court of this state requiring the 16 individual to participate in the twenty four seven sobriety program authorized in 17 sections 54-12-27 through 54-12-31 is guilty of a class B misdemeanor. If a law-18 enforcement officer has reasonable cause to believe an individual has violated a lawful-19 order of a court of this state requiring the person to participate in the twenty-four seven-20 sobriety program, the law enforcement officer may arrest the individual without a 21 warrant and take the individual into custody. An individual arrested under this 22 subsection may not be released on bail or on the individual's personal recognizance 23 unless the individual has made a personal appearance before a magistrate.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.

**SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 29-06-15 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

If a law enforcement officer has reasonable cause to believe an individual has violated a lawful order of a court of this state which requires the individual to participate in the twenty-four seven sobriety program authorized in sections 54-12-27 through 54-12-31, the law enforcement officer may take the individual into custody without a warrant. An individual taken into custody under this subsection may not be released on bail or on the individual's personal recognizance unless the individual has made a personal appearance before a magistrate.

**SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
