1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 57-39.2-26.1 of the North-

2 Dakota Century Code, relating to the allocation of revenues among political subdivisions-

3 through the state aid distribution fund; to provide an expiration date; and to declare an

4 emergency.for an Act to amend and reenact section 57-39.2-26.1 of the North Dakota Century

5 Code, relating to the allocation of funds in the state aid distribution fund; and to provide an

6 <u>effective date.</u>

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 57-39.2-26.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 9 created and enacted as follows: 10 The population figures used for the allocation of revenues to counties and cities under 11 subsections 1 and 2 must be the population figures determined by the 2000 federal-12 decennial census. 13 SECTION 2. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through July 31, 2013, and after that 14 date is ineffective. 15 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure. 16 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 57-39.2-26.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 17 amended and reenacted as follows: 18 57-39.2-26.1. Allocation of revenues among political subdivisions. 19 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a portion of sales, gross receipts, use, and 20 motor vehicle excise tax collections, equal to forty percent of an amount determined by 21 multiplying the quotient of one percent divided by the general sales tax rate, that was in effect 22 when the taxes were collected, times the net sales, gross receipts, use, and motor vehicle 23 excise tax collections under chapters 57-39.2, 57-39.5, 57-39.6, 57-40.2, and 57-40.3 must be 24 deposited by the state treasurer in the state aid distribution fund. The state tax commissioner

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1	shall certify to the state treasurer the portion of sales, gross receipts, use, and motor vehicle						
2	excise tax net revenues that must be deposited in the state aid distribution fund as determined						
3	under th	under this section. Revenues deposited in the state aid distribution fund are provided as a					
4	standing	nding and continuing appropriation and must be allocated as follows:					
5	1.	Fifty	/-thre	e and seven-tenths percent of the revenues must be allocated to counties in			
6		the first month after each quarterly period as provided in this subsection.					
7		a.	Sixt	y-four percent of the amount must be allocated among the seventeen			
8			cou	nties with the greatest population, in the following manner:			
9			(1)	Thirty-two percent of the amount must be allocated equally among the			
10				counties; and			
11			(2)	The remaining amount must be allocated based upon the proportion each			
12				such county's population bears to the total population of all such counties.			
13		b.	Thir	ty-six percent of the amount must be allocated among all counties, excluding			
14			the	seventeen counties with the greatest population, in the following manner:			
15			(1)	Forty percent of the amount must be allocated equally among the counties;			
16				and			
17			(2)	The remaining amount must be allocated based upon the proportion each			
18				such county's population bears to the total population of all such counties.			
19		A co	ounty	shall deposit all revenues received under this subsection in the county			
20		general fund. Each county shall reserve a portion of its allocation under this					
21		subsection for further distribution to, or expenditure on behalf of, townships, rural fire					
22		protection districts, rural ambulance districts, soil conservation districts, county					
23		recreation service districts, county hospital districts, the Garrison Diversion					
24		Conservancy District, the southwest water authority, and other taxing districts within					
25		the county, excluding school districts, cities, and taxing districts within cities. The share					
26		of the county allocation under this subsection to be distributed to a township must be					
27		equal to the percentage of the county share of state aid distribution fund allocations					
28	that township received during calendar year 1996. The governing boards of the county						
29		and	town	ship may agree to a different distribution.			

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1	2.	Forty-six and three-tenths percent of the revenues must be allocated to cities in the
2		first month after each quarterly period as provided in this subsection based upon the
3		proportion each city's population bears to the total population of all cities.
4		a. Nineteen and four-tenths percent of the amount must be allocated among cities
5		with a population of eighty thousand or more, based upon the proportion each-
6		city's population bears to the total population of all such cities.
7		b. Thirty-four and five-tenths percent of the amount must be allocated among cities
8		with a population of twenty thousand or more but fewer than eighty thousand,
9		based upon the proportion each such city's population bears to the total
10		population of all such cities.
11		-c. Sixteen percent of the amount must be allocated among cities with a population-
12		of ten thousand or more but fewer than twenty thousand, based upon the
13		proportion each such city's population bears to the total population of all such
14		<del>cities.</del>
15		d. Four and nine-tenths percent of the amount must be allocated among cities with
16		a population of five thousand or more but fewer than ten thousand, based upon-
17		the proportion each such city's population bears to the total population of all such
18		cities.
19		e. Thirteen and one-tenth percent of the amount must be allocated among cities
20		with a population of one thousand or more but fewer than five thousand, based-
21		upon the proportion each such city's population bears to the total population of all
22		such cities.
23		f. Six and one-tenth percent of the amount must be allocated among cities with a
24		population of five hundred or more but fewer than one thousand, based upon the-
25		proportion each such city's population bears to the total population of all such
26		cities.
27		g. Three and four-tenths percent of the amount must be allocated among cities with
28		a population of two hundred or more but fewer than five hundred, based upon the
29		proportion each such city's population bears to the total population of all such
30		cities.

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1	h. Two and six-tenths percent of the amount must be allocated among cities with a
2	population of fewer than two hundred, based upon the proportion each such city's-
3	population bears to the total population of all such cities.
4	A city shall deposit all revenues received under this subsection in the city general fund.
5	Each city shall reserve a portion of its allocation under this subsection for further
6	distribution to, or expenditure on behalf of, park districts and other taxing districts
7	within the city, excluding school districts. The share of the city allocation under this
8	subsection to be distributed to a park district must be equal to the percentage of the
9	city share of state aid distribution fund allocations that park district received during
10	calendar year 1996, up to a maximum of thirty percent. The governing boards of the
11	city and park district may agree to a different distribution.
12	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act becomes effective on July 1, 2011.
