## **SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4010**

1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study the adequacy of
2	governmental services, including judicial services, to respond to issues relating to an aging
3	population, including veterans, and to study the efficacy of statutes governing public
4	administrator services and methods for the timely and effective delivery of guardianship and
5	public administrator responsibilities and services.
6	WHEREAS, during the 2003-04 interim, a study of guardianship services by the interim
7	Criminal Justice Committee, with the assistance of the North Dakota Guardianship Task Force,
8	identified important deficiencies in the funding and effective delivery of guardianship services
9	and during subsequent years new issues may have arisen; and
10	WHEREAS, legislation recommended by the interim Criminal Justice Committee to address
11	the deficiencies was not enacted and methods for the effective delivery of guardianship services
12	generally, and public guardianship services in particular, remain uncertain, inconsistent, and
13	lacking in sufficient funding and the unsupervised use of representative payees and powers of
14	attorney agreements have raised important new concerns; and
15	WHEREAS, state law governing public administrators, a critically important form of public
16	guardianship, is vague and incomplete with respect to services to be provided, levels of
17	supervision, general accountability, the responsibility to adequately compensate those who are
18	appointed to serve as public administrators, and the role of the courts in responding to unique
19	issues associated with an aging population; and
20	WHEREAS, there is also a need to study issues of public administrator services and
21	methods for the timely and effective delivery of guardianship services as they relate to the aging
22	veteran population in this state; and
23	WHEREAS, other states have considered or implemented different models for the provision
24	of public guardianship services to ensure adequate services, oversight, and the availability of

qualified individuals to provide guardianship services;

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## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Legislative Management study the adequacy of governmental services, including judicial services, to respond to issues relating to an aging population, including veterans, and to study the efficacy of statutes governing public administrator services and methods for the timely and effective delivery of guardianship and public administrator responsibilities and services; and **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the Sixty-third Legislative Assembly.
