- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15 of chapter 3 of the 2011 Session Laws,
- 2 relating to authorization of the state board of higher education to issue revenue bonds; to
- 3 provide legislative intent; to provide appropriations an appropriation; and to provide an effective
- 4 date.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15 of chapter 3 of the 2011 Session Laws is amended and reenacted as follows:

SECTION 15. BOND ISSUANCE AUTHORIZATION - PURPOSES -

APPROPRIATION. The state board of higher education, in accordance with chapter 15-55, may arrange for the funding of projects authorized in this section, declared to be in the public interest, through the issuance of self-liquidating, tax-exempt evidences of indebtedness under chapter 15-55, beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2013. Evidences of indebtedness issued pursuant to this section are not a general obligation of the state of North Dakota. Any unexpended balance resulting from the proceeds of the evidences of indebtedness must be placed in a sinking fund to be used for the retirement of indebtedness. The evidences of indebtedness may be issued and the proceeds are appropriated, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, for the purpose of financing the following capital projects: Bismarck state college student union renovation and addition \$7,000,000 Williston state college workforce training center 1,725,000 14,000,000 University of North Dakota - Wilkerson hall renovation and addition University of North Dakota - University town home apartments 5,000,000 North Dakota state college of science - Forkner hall renovation 5,000,000

4	SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - NORTH DAKOTA STATE COLLEGE OF SCIENCE	
5	APPROPRIATION. It is the intent of the sixty-second Legislative Assembly that the \$4,000,000	
6	f estimated income from revenue bond proceeds appropriated in House Bill No. 1003, as	
7	approved by the sixty-second legislative assembly, to the North Dakota state college of science	
8	for the Schulz hall renovation project be used instead for the Riley hall renovation project, for	
9	the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.	
0	SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - WILLISTON STATE COLLEGE. The funds provided in	
11	this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of	any moneys
2	in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to Williston state college for	
3	various campus needs, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending-	
4	June 30, 2013, as follows:

22	seek funding from the sixty-third legislative assembly to continue the faculty and staff salary	
23	increases and the security officer position during the 2013-15 biennium.	
24	SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - DICKINSON STATE UNIVERSITY - BUDGE	T SECTION
25	APPROVAL. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury,	
26	not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,500,000, or so much of the sum as may be	
27	ecessary, to Dickinson state university for campus needs, for the period beginning with the	
28	ffective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2013. The funds provided in this section may only	
29	be expended by Dickinson state university upon receiving budget section approval for use of	
30	the funds for specific projects or program needs.	

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1	SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - DICKINSON STATE UNIVERSITY THEODORE	
2	ROOSEVELT CENTER APPROPRIATION. It is the intent of the sixty-second legislative	
3	assembly that the \$750,000 general fund appropriation provided in House Bill No. 1003, as	
4	approved by the sixty-second legislative assembly, to Dickinson state university for the	
5	digitization of documents related to the Theodore Roosevelt center may be used for any projec	
6	or program related to the Theodore Roosevelt center, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011,	
7	and ending June 30, 2013.	
8	SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - WILLISTON STATE COLLEGE. There is appropriated	

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - WILLISTON STATE COLLEGE. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$2,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to Williston state college for public safety or other unusual or unexpected expenses due to the impact of oil and gas development in the region, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2013. The funding provided in this section is considered one-time funding.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act becomes effective December 1, 2011.
