1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15 of chapter 3 of the 2011 Session Laws,

2 relating to authorization of the state board of higher education to issue revenue bonds; to

3 provide legislative intent; to provide an appropriation; and to provide an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15 of chapter 3 of the 2011 Session Laws is amended
6 and reenacted as follows:

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SECTION 15. BOND ISSUANCE AUTHORIZATION - PURPOSES -

8 **APPROPRIATION.** The state board of higher education, in accordance with chapter 9 15-55, may arrange for the funding of projects authorized in this section, declared to 10 be in the public interest, through the issuance of self-liquidating, tax-exempt evidences 11 of indebtedness under chapter 15-55, beginning with the effective date of this Act and 12 ending June 30, 2013. Evidences of indebtedness issued pursuant to this section are 13 not a general obligation of the state of North Dakota. Any unexpended balance 14 resulting from the proceeds of the evidences of indebtedness must be placed in a 15 sinking fund to be used for the retirement of indebtedness. The evidences of 16 indebtedness may be issued and the proceeds are appropriated, for the biennium 17 beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, for the purpose of financing the 18 following capital projects: 19 Bismarck state college student union renovation and addition \$7,000,000 20 Williston state college workforce training center 1,725,000

3	SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - NORTH DAKOTA STATE COLLEGE OF SCIENCE		
4	APPROPRIATION. It is the intent of the sixty-second Legislative Assembly that the \$4,000,000		
5	of estimated income from revenue bond proceeds appropriated in House Bill No. 1003, as		
6	approved by the sixty-second legislative assembly, to the North Dakota state college of science		
7	for the Schulz hall renovation project be used instead for the Riley hall renovation project, for		
8	the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.		
9	SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - DICKINSON STATE UNIVERSITY THEODORE		
10	ROOSEVELT CENTER APPROPRIATION. It is the intent of the sixty-second legislative		
11	assembly that the \$750,000 general fund appropriation provided in House Bill No. 1003, as		
12	approved by the sixty-second legislative assembly, to Dickinson state university for the		
13	digitization of documents related to the Theodore Roosevelt center may be used for any project	t	
14	or program related to the Theodore Roosevelt center, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011,		
15	and ending June 30, 2013.		
16	SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - WILLISTON STATE COLLEGE. There is appropriated		
17	out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sun	n	
18	of \$2,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to Williston state college for public		
19	safety or other unusual or unexpected expenses due to the impact of oil and gas development		
20	in the region, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30,		
21	2013. The funding provided in this section is considered one-time funding.		
22	SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act becomes effective December 1, 2011.
