4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-25-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

- "Commercial driver training school" or "school" means a business enterprise conducted by an individual, association, partnership, corporation, or limited liability companya person for the education and training of persons individuals, either practically or theoretically, or both, to operate or drive a motor vehicles vehicle, and charging afor which accepts consideration or charges tuition for such servicesthe service.
- 2. "Instructor" means any personan individual, whether acting on that person's individual's own behalf as an operator of a commercial driver training school or for such a school for compensation, who teaches, conducts classes of a class for, gives demonstrations to, or supervises practice of, persons an individual learning to operate or drive a motor vehicles vehicle.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 39-25-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

2	All licenses expire Alicense expires on the last day of the calendar year and may be
3	renewed upon application to the superintendentdirector as prescribed by the
4	superintendent's director's regulations. Each application for an original or renewal school license
5	must be accompanied by a fee of twenty-five dollars, and each application for an original or
6	renewal instructor's license must be accompanied by a fee of ten dollars. Such These fees must
7	be deposited in the state treasury in the state highway fund. No license License fees may not be
8	refunded in the event any license is rejected, suspended, or revoked.
9	SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 39-25-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
10	amended and reenacted as follows:
11	39-25-06. Refusal, suspension, or revocation of license.
12	The superintendent director may refuse to issue, or may suspend or revoke a license in any
13	case when the superintendent director finds the applicant or licensee has violated any of the
14	provisions of this chapter or the regulations adopted by the superintendentdirector. A suspended
15	or revoked license must be returned to the superintendent director by the licensee.
16	SECTION 7. AMENDMENT. Section 39-25-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is
17	amended and reenacted as follows:
18	39-25-07. Exclusions - Free instruction - Colleges, universities, and high schools.
19	This chapter does not apply to any person giving driver training lessons without charge, to
20	employers maintaining driver training schools without charge solely for theirthat employer's
21	employees enly, nor to schools a school or classes a class conducted by colleges a college,
22	universities a university, and high schools or a high school for a regularly enrolled full-time or
23	part-time studentsstudent as a part of a normal program for such institutions of the institution.
