- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 47-16 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to definition of commencement of drilling operations.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 47-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

6 <u>Commencement of drilling operations - Definition.</u>

- 7 <u>1.</u> This section applies to an oil and gas lease executed after July 31, 2013. As used in
- 8 an oil and gas lease, unless otherwise expressly provided in the oil and gas lease, the
- 9 <u>terms "engaged in drilling or reworking operations" or "commence drilling or reworking</u>
 10 operations" mean:
- a. Well site preparation, staking, and surveying in connection with the drilling of a
 well on the leased premises or lands pooled must occur before the expiration of
 the primary term.
- 14b.The drill site must be substantially completed and in a condition that a drilling rig.15can be moved on the location within fifteen days of the expiration of the primary16term.
- 17 c. For one well located on a single well drilling pad, a drilling rig capable of drilling to
 18 at least the total vertical depth permitted must be located at the site within
 19 forty-five days of the expiration of the primary term.
- 20d.For multiple wells located on a drilling pad constructed for two or more wells, a21drilling rig capable of drilling to at least the total vertical depth must be located at22the site within ninety days of the expiration of the primary term.

- 1 <u>2.</u> If the activities required under this section are delayed or interrupted by event of force
- 2 <u>majeure, the time of such delay or interruption during the force majeure event must be</u>
- 3 <u>added to the deadlines set forth in this section.</u>
