- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 4-12.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to an apiary setback; and to provide an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 4-12.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 5 and enacted as follows:
- 6 Placement of apiary Distance from paved road.
- Beginning January 1, 2014, a person may not place an apiary within six hundred sixty yards
- 8 [603.5 meters] of the centerline of a paved road.
- 9 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
- 10 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$900,000, or so much of the
- 11 sum as may be necessary, to the agriculture commissioner for the purpose of enforcing apiary
- setback requirements, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.
