- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new sections to chapter 15.1 07 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the provisions of educational services by school districts and to the
- 3 closure of a school.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

7 <u>School district - Provision of educational services.</u>

- Beginning July 1, 2015, each school district shall offer educational services to students
 from kindergarten through grade twelve.
- <u>Any school district that is unable to meet the requirement set forth in subsection 1</u>
 shall:
- 12 a. Become reorganized in accordance with chapter 15.1-21.1 by July 1, 2015; or
- 13 b. Dissolve, in accordance with chapter 15.1-21.1, by July 1, 2015.
- 14 <u>3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law, beginning July 1, 2015, the superintendent of public
- 15 instruction may not forward state aid payments to a district that does not meet the
 16 requirements of subsection 1.
- 17 SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 15.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 18 and enacted as follows:
- 19 <u>Closure of school Required vote.</u>
- 20 Before the board of a school district may close a school located within the boundary of a
- 21 district that was required to undergo reorganization or dissolution under section 1 of this Act, the
- 22 <u>board shall place the question of closing the school on the ballot. The question may be voted</u>
- 23 upon only by those qualified electors who reside within the boundary of the district that was
- 24 required to undergo reorganization or dissolution under section 1 of this Act. The board may not

- 1 close the school unless a majority of the qualified electors voting on the question approve the
- 2 <u>closure.</u>
