A BILL for an Act to create and enact twothree new subsections to section 43-48-03 of the North 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to exemptions from clinical laboratory practice licensing 3 requirements; to amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 43-48-05 of the North Dakota 4 Century Code, relating to terms of North Dakota board of clinical laboratory practice members; 5 and to repeal section 43-48-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to clinical laboratory 6 practice licensing grandfather provisions. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 8 **SECTION 1.** Two Three new subsections to section 43-48-03 of the North Dakota Century 9 Code are created and enacted as follows: 10 Perfusionists performing clinical laboratory tests for hematology, coagulation, and 11 chemistry during the course of a patient's perfusion procedures. 12 Personnel of the division of laboratory services of the state department of health 13 participating in the centers for disease control and prevention's chemical terrorism 14 toxic metals determination program. 15 A person licensed or registered under another chapter of this title and carrying out the 16 therapy or practice for which the person is licensed or registered. 17 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of section 43-48-05 of the North Dakota Century 18 Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 19 3. The members of the board shall serve for terms of three years, except that members-20 of the first board must be appointed as provided in this chapter within sixty days after

July 12, 1989, for the following terms:

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1	a.	A nonphysician laboratory director member and a consumer member, each for a
2		term of three years.
3	b.	A clinical laboratory technician member and clinical laboratory scientist member,
4		each for a term of two years.
5	c.	A physician laboratory director member and a consumer member, each for a term
6		of one year.
7	d.	The state officer member or such officer's designee must be appointed and serve
8		ex officio during such term of office in the state department of health.
9	SECTION	3. REPEAL. Section 43-48-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.
