- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 19-03.5-02 and subdivision e of subsection 3 of
- 2 section 19-03.5-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to state board of pharmacy
- 3 prescription monitoring programs and access to prescription drug information.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 19-03.5-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is

- 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 **19-03.5-02.** Requirements for prescription drug monitoring program.
- The board shall establish and maintain a program for the monitoring of prescribing and
 dispensing of all controlled substances.
- 10 2. Each dispenser shall submit to the board by electronic means information regarding
- 11 each prescription dispensed for a controlled substance. The information submitted for-
- 12 each prescription must include all of the data elements in the American Society for
- 13 Automation in Pharmacy Rules-Based Standard Implementation Guide for Prescription-
- 14 Monitoring Programs issued August 31, 2005, version 003, release 000. The board
- 15 shall establish and update rules to direct dispensers on the version of the American
- 16 Society for Automation in Pharmacy Rules-Based Standard Implementation Guide for
- Prescription Monitoring Programs in which the dispensing history must be submitted to
 the central repository.
- Each dispenser shall submit the information in accordance with transmission methods
 and frequency established by the board.
- 4. The board may issue an extension of time to a dispenser that is unable to submitprescription information by electronic means.
- 23 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision e of subsection 3 of section 19-03.5-03 of the
- 24 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

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- 1 e. The department of human services for purposes regarding the utilization of
- 2 controlled substances by a medicaid recipient <u>or establishment and enforcement</u>
- 3 <u>of child support and medical support;</u>
