1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision c of subsection 1 of section 11-18-05. 2 section 24-01-25, and subsection 2 of section 35-24-13 of the North Dakota Century Code, 3 relating to fees and notice requirements of the county recorder; to repeal section 35-22-19 of 4 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to a failure to record in a foreclosure; and to provide 5 for a legislative management study. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 7 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subdivision c of subsection 1 of section 11-18-05 of the North 8 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 9 Plats, irregular tracts, or annexations, ten dollars for one lot plus ten cents for 10 each additional lot, with the exception of auditor's lots which must be a single-11 charge of sevenfifty dollars. 12 SECTION 2.
