- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 12-44.1-01 and 12-44.1-04 and subsection 1
- 2 of section 12-44.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to correctional facilities.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 12-44.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **12-44.1-01. Definitions.**
- 7 As used in this chapter:
- 8 1. "Administrator" means the sheriff, chief of police, administrator, superintendent,
- 9 director, or other individual serving as the chief executive officer of a correctional
- 10 facility.
- 11 2. "Adult lockup" means a secure temporary-hold nonresidential facility that does not
- hold individuals overnight and includes a facility with cuffing rails or cuffing benches.
- 13 <u>3.</u> "Correctional facility" means a city or county jail or detention center, regional
- 14 corrections center, or juvenile detention center for the detention or confinement of
- persons in accordance with law. The use of the term does not imply and may not be
- used to require the provision of services including treatment, counseling, career and
- technical education, or other educational services, except as may otherwise be
- required or provided for under this chapter.
- 19 3.4. "Correctional facility staff" means correctional personnel with titles such as jailer,
- deputy, counselor, correctional officer, or any other title, whose duties include the
- 21 ongoing supervision of inmates in a correctional facility.
- 22 4.5. "Court holding facility" means a secure facility, other than an adult correctional facility
- or adult lockup, used to temporarily detain individuals before or after a detention
- 24 <u>hearing or other court proceedings, and is not used to detain individuals overnight.</u>

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- 1 "Inmate" means any personindividual, whether sentenced or unsentenced, who is 2 detained or confined in a correctional facility. The term does not include an individual 3 who is under the supervision of the correctional facility and is supervised under home 4 detention, electronic monitoring, or a similar program that does not involve physical 5 detention or confinement in the facility. 6 5.7. "Jail" means a correctional facility, including a county or city jail or a regional
- 7 corrections center.
- 8 6.8. "Juvenile detention center" means a publicly or privately established and maintained 9 correctional facility for the detention of juveniles. The term does not include the North 10 Dakota youth correctional center.
- 11 7.9. "Regional corrections center" means a correctional facility established and maintained 12 by more than one county or city, or a combination of counties and cities, for the 13 confinement of inmates.
- 14 8.10. "Trained correctional facility staff" means correctional personnel who have completed 15 a course of training approved by the department of corrections and rehabilitation peace 16 officer standards and training board.
 - SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 12-44.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 19 12-44.1-04. Administration - Organization - Management.
- 20 The administrator of each correctional facility shall:
- 21 Formulate an operations manual, available to all correctional facility staff, which 22 delineates the written policies and procedures for operating and maintaining the 23 correctional facility.
- 24 2. Review and update all policies and procedures in the operations manual at least 25 annually.
- 26 Specify an administrator in the operations manual to whom all correctional facility staff 3. 27 are responsible. The operations manual shall include the administrator's duties, 28 responsibilities, and authority for the management of the correctional facility staff, 29 inmates, programs, and physical plant.

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1 Ensure that correctional facility staff who work in direct and continuing contact with 2 inmates receive correctional facility training as determined and approved by the 3 department of corrections and rehabilitation peace officer standards and training board. 4 SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 12-44.1-06 of the North Dakota 5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 6 The department of corrections and rehabilitation shall, following inspection pursuant to 7 section 12-44.1-24, grade correctional facilities as to length of allowable inmate 8 confinement based upon construction, size, and usage, as follows: 9 "Grade one" means a correctional facility for confining inmates not more than one a. 10 year. 11 "Grade two" means a correctional facility for confining inmates not more than b. 12 ninety days. 13 "Grade three" means a correctional facility for confining inmates not more than C. 14 ninety-six hours. 15 "Grade four" means an adult lockup or court holding facility in which individuals <u>d.</u> 16 may not be detained overnight.
