- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 26.1-36 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 54-52.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to insurance coverage of cancer
- 3 treatment medications.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 26.1-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

7 <u>Coverage of cancer treatment medications.</u>

- 8 <u>1.</u> <u>As used in this section:</u>
- 9a."Cancer treatment medications" means prescription drugs and biologics that are10used to kill, slow, or prevent the growth of cancerous cells.
- b. <u>"Insurer" means an insurance company, nonprofit health service corporation, or</u>
 health maintenance organization.
- 13 <u>c.</u> <u>"Patient-administered" includes oral administration and self-injection.</u>
- 14d."Policy" means a major medical expense policy, contract, or evidence of15coverage on a group, individual, blanket, franchise, or association basis.
- An insurer may not deliver, issue, execute, or renew a policy that provides coverage
 for cancer treatment medications that are injected or are intravenously administered
- 18 by a health care provider and that provides coverage for patient-administered cancer
- 19 treatment medications unless the policy copayment, deductible, and coinsurance
- 20 <u>amounts for patient-administered cancer treatment medications do not exceed the</u>
- 21 <u>amounts for cancer treatment medications that are injected or are intravenously</u>
- 22 administered by a health care provider, regardless of the formulation or benefit
- 23 <u>category.</u>

1	<u>3.</u>	An insurer may not increase a copayment, deductible, or coinsurance amount for
2		covered cancer treatment medications that are injected or intravenously administered
3		in order to avoid compliance with subsection 2. An insurer may increase a copayment,
4		deductible, and coinsurance amount for covered cancer treatment medications if the
5		increase is applied generally to other medical or pharmaceutical benefits under the
6		contract and is not done to circumvent subsection 2. An insurer may not reclassify
7		benefits with respect to cancer treatment medications in a manner that is inconsistent
8		with this section.
9	SEC	CTION 2. A new section to chapter 54-52.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
10	and enacted as follows:	
11	Coverage of cancer treatment medications.	
12	The board shall provide medical benefits coverage under a contract for insurance pursuant	

- 13 to section 54-52.1-04 or under a self-insurance plan pursuant to section 54-52.1-04.2 which
- 14 provides coverage of cancer treatment medications in the same manner as provided under
- 15 <u>section 1 of this Act.</u>
