- 2 Code, relating to North Dakota scholarships; and to provide an appropriation.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-21-02.6 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows: 6 15.1-21-02.6. North Dakota scholarship - Amount - Applicability. 7 The state board of higher education shall provide to any student who 8 graduates from high school before the 2014-15 school year and who is 9 certified as being eligible by the superintendent of public instruction either a 10 North Dakota academic scholarship or a North Dakota career and technical 11 education scholarship, in the amount of seven hundred fifty dollars, for each 12 semester during which the student is enrolled full time at an accredited 13 institution of higher education in this state and maintains a cumulative grade 14 point average of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 grading scale. 15 The state board of higher education shall provide to any student who <del>b.</del> <u>(2)</u> 16 graduates from high school before the 2014-15 school year and who is 17 certified as being eligible by the superintendent of public instruction either a 18 North Dakota academic scholarship or a North Dakota career and technical 19 education scholarship, in the amount of five hundred dollars, for each 20 quarter during which the student is enrolled full time at an accredited 21 institution of higher education in this state and maintains a cumulative grade

- 1 A scholarship under this section is available to any eligible resident student who fulfills 2 the requirements of section 15.1-21-02.4 or 15.1-21-02.5 and who: 3 a. Graduates from a high school in this state; 4 Graduates from a high school in a bordering state under chapter 15.1-29; b. 5 Graduates from a nonpublic high school in a bordering state while residing with a C. 6 custodial parent in this state; or 7 Completes a program of home education supervised in accordance with chapter d. 8 15.1-23. 9 7. a. For purposes of North Dakota scholarship eligibility under this section, "full-time" 10 means enrollment in at least twelve credits during a student's first two semesters 11 and enrollment in at least fifteen credits during each semester thereafter or 12 enrollment in the equivalent number of credits, as determined by the state board 13 of higher education, with respect to students in a guarter system. 14 If a student requires fewer than fifteen credits to graduate, the student may b. 15 retain scholarship eligibility by enrolling in fewer than fifteen but at least 16 twelve credits during the semester, or the equivalent number of credits, as 17 determined by the state board of higher education, with respect to students 18 in a quarter system. 19 Students who graduated from high school during the 2009-10 or the (2) 20 2010-11 school year and who have completed six semesters may retain 21 scholarship eligibility by enrolling in only twelve credits during each of the 22 student's final two semesters, or the equivalent number of credits, as 23 determined by the state board of higher education, with respect to students 24 in a quarter system. 25
  - (3) The requirement that a student be enrolled in at least fifteen credits, as set forth in subdivision a, does not apply in the case of a student participating in a clinical, practicum, internship, cooperative program, or similar external experience, provided the external experience is equivalent to at least twelve units, or such similar amount as determined by the state board of higher education, with respect to students in a quarter system, and considered to be a "full time" placement for purposes of meeting graduation requirements.

## SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION - NORTH DAKOTA SCHOLARSHIPS. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_\_, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state board of higher education for the purpose of providing academic and career and technical education scholarships, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
