BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 10-31-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 10-31-06. Executives and owners.
- NoAn individual may benot simultaneously be an executive or owner of more than one
 professional organization rendering the same professional service.
 - 2. A professional organization in the form of a corporation which has only one shareholder need have only one director, who must be the shareholder. That individual also shall serve as the president and treasurer of the corporation. The other officers of the corporation need not be licensed or otherwise legally authorized in the same field of endeavor as the president.
 - 3. A retired individual may not continue as an executive or owner of a professional organization.
 - **SECTION 2.** A new subsection to section 10-31-13 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
 - In order to regulate organizations that have ownership that renders more than one professional service, the secretary of state shall collect one thousand dollars for articles of incorporation for a corporation, articles of organization for a limited liability company, or articles of amendment related to an organization that has ownership that renders more than one professional service. This fee is in addition to the fees provided
