- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 39-06.2-19 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to fees for commercial driver's licenses; and to amend and reenact sections 39-06.2-07,
- 3 39-06.2-08, 39-06.2-09, 39-06.2-09.1, and 39-06.2-13.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 4 relating to commercial driver's licenses.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-06.2-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:

8 **39-06.2-07.** Commercial driver's license qualification standards.

9 1. Testing.

10 General. No personAn individual may not be issued a commercial driver's license a. 11 unless that personindividual is a resident of this state and; has passed a 12 knowledge and skills test for driving a commercial motor vehicle which complies 13 with minimum federal standards established by federal regulations enumerated in 14 49 CFR part 383, subparts G and H₇; and has satisfied all other requirements of 15 state law and federal law, including the Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Act in-16 addition to other requirements imposed by state law or federal regulation. The 17 tests must be prescribed and conducted by the director. The applicant must pay 18 athe fee of five dollarslisted in section 39-06.2-19 for each of the tests.

- b.<u>2.</u> Third-party testing. The director may authorize a person, including an agency of this or another<u>a</u> state, an employer, a private driver's training facility, or other private
 institution, or a department, agency, or instrumentality of local government, to
 administer the skills test specified by this section, provided if:

6	<u>3.4.</u>	Lim	itations on issuance of license. A commercial driver's license, or commercial
7		driv	ver's instruction permit , may not be issued to a personan individual while the
8		per	sonindividual is subject to a disqualification from driving a commercial motor
9		veh	icle, or while the person'sindividual's driver's license is suspended, revoked, or
10		can	celed in any state; nor may a. A commercial driver's license may not be issued to a-
11		per	sonan individual who has a commercial driver's license issued by any other state
12		unle	ess the person<u>individual</u> first surrenders all such licenses from other states. The
13		dire	ector shall notify the issuing state of the surrender of the license.
14	<u>4.5.</u>	Cor	mmercial driver's instruction permit. An individual who has been a resident of this
15		<u>stat</u>	te for thirty days may not drive a commercial motor vehicle under the authority of a
16		<u>con</u>	nmercial driver's license issued by another jurisdiction.
17	<u>6.</u>	a.	A commercial driver's instruction permit may be issued to an individual who holds
18			a valid class D driver's license who has passed the vision and written tests
19			required for an equivalent commercial driver's license.
20		b.	The commercial driver's instruction permit may not be issued for a period to
21			exceed six monthsone hundred eighty days. Only one renewal or reissuance may
22			be granted within a two-year period. The director may issue a letter of authority
23			that authorizes the applicant to drive to a driver's license office, complete the
24			road test, and return home. The <u>director may issue the</u> letter of authority is used
25			after an <u>if all</u> allowable number of permits have been issued. The holder of a
26			commercial driver's instruction permit may, unless otherwise disqualified, drive a
27			commercial motor vehicle only when accompanied by the holder of a commercial
28			driver's license valid for the type of vehicle driven who occupies a seat beside the
29			individual for the purpose of giving instruction in driving the commercial motor
30			vehicle.

21		and	proof of residence address.

23		mail	ing address, an application for a duplicate license must be made as provided

25	4.	An i	ndividual who has been a resident of this state for thirty days may not drive a	
26		com	mercial motor vehicle under the authority of a commercial driver's license issued	
27		by a	nother jurisdiction.	
28	5.	Any	individual who knowingly falsifies information or certifications required under	
29		subs	section 1 is subject to suspension, revocation, cancellation, or disqualification of	
30		the i	ndividual's commercial driver's license or pending application for a period of at	
31		leas	t sixty consecutive days.	

1	SEC	TION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06.2-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
2	amended and reenacted as follows:			
3	39-0	39-06.2-09. Commercial driver's license.		
4	1.	The commercial driver's license must be marked "commercial driver's license", and		
5		must be, to the maximum extent practicable, tamper proof. It must include the		
6		following information:		
7		a. The name and residential address of the personindividual;		
8		b. The person's individual's color photograph;		
9		c. A physical description of the personindividual, including sex, height, and eye		
10		color;		
11		d. Date of birth;		
12		e. A distinguishing number assigned to the personindividual;		
13		f. The person's individual's signature;		
14		g. The class or type of commercial motor vehicle or vehicles which the		
15		personindividual is authorized to drive together with any endorsements or		
16		restrictions;		
17		h. The name of this state; and		
18		i. The dates between which the license is valid.		
19	2.	The director may issue a nonresident commercial driver's license pursuant tounder the		
20		limitations of 49 CFR 383 including waiving the social security number requirement.		
21		The face of the license must be marked "nonresident" in accordance with 49 CFR		
22		383.153(b).		
23	3.	Commercial driver's licenses may be issued with the following classifications,		
24		endorsements, and restrictions; the. The holder of a valid commercial driver's license		
25		may drive all vehicles in the class for which that license is issued and all lesser		
26		classes of vehicles except motorcycles. Vehicles for which an endorsement is required		
27		may not be driven unless the proper endorsement appears on the license. The		
28		requirements of placarding vehicles transporting hazardous materials under		
29		subparagraph b of paragraph 3 of subdivision a and the endorsement required under		
30		paragraph 1 of subdivision b do not apply to a person who is the operator of a farm		
31		vehicle, provided suchif the vehicle is controlled and operated by a farmer and used to

1	transport hazardous materials in the form of farm supplies within one hundred fifty
2	miles [241.40 kilometers] of the farm, and not used in the operations of a common or
3	contract carrier.

- 4 a. Classifications The classifications of commercial driver's licenses are:
- 5 (1) ClassA class A license. AnyThis license allows the operation of any
 6 combination of vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating of more than
 7 twenty-six thousand pounds [11793.40 kilograms], providedif the gross
 8 vehicle weight rating of the vehicles being towed is in excess of ten
 9 thousand pounds [4535.92 kilograms].
- 10(2)ClassA class B license. AnyThis license allows the operation of a single11vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating of more than twenty-six thousand12pounds [11793.40 kilograms], and any suchthis vehicle towing a vehicle not13in excess of ten thousand pounds [4535.92 kilograms].
- 14(3)ClassA class C license. AnyThis license allows the operation of a single15vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating of twenty-six thousand pounds16[11793.40 kilograms] or less or any suchthis vehicle towing a vehicle with a17gross vehicle weight rating not in excess of ten thousand pounds18[4535.92 kilograms] comprising:
 - (a) Vehicles designed to transport sixteen or more passengers, including the driver; and
 - (b) Vehicles used in the transportation of hazardous materials which requires the vehicle to be placarded under 49 CFR part 172, subpart F.
 - b. Endorsements and restrictions include:
 - "H" -<u>that</u> authorizes the driver to drive a vehicle transporting hazardous materials.
 - (2) "T" -<u>that</u> authorizes driving double and triple trailers.
 - (3) "P" -<u>that</u> authorizes driving vehicles carrying passengers.
 - (4) "N" -<u>that</u> authorizes driving tank vehicles.
- 30 (5) "X" -<u>that authorizes driving</u> combinations of tank vehicles and hazardous
 31 material vehicles.

1		(6) "S" -that authorizes driving a schoolbus.
2		c. Other restrictions may be placed upon a commercial driver's license, as provided
3		in <u>under</u> section 39-06-17. The applicant shall pay a fee of three dollarslisted in
4		section 39-06.2-19 for each endorsement.
5	4.	Before issuing a commercial driver's license, the director shall obtain driving record
6		information through the commercial driver's license information system, the national
7		driver's register, and from each state in which the personindividual has been licensed.
8	5.	Within ten days after issuing a commercial driver's license, the director shall notify the
9		commercial driver's license information system of that fact, providing all information
10		required to ensure identification of the personindividual.
11	6.	A commercial driver's license issued under this chapter expires in the manner
12		provided for operator's licenses under section 39-06-19.
13	7.	Every personAn individual applying for renewal of a commercial driver's license must
14		complete the application form required by subsection 1 of section 39-06.2-08,-
15		providing and provide updated information and required certifications. If the For an
16		applicant wishes to retain a hazardous materials endorsement, the applicant must take
17		and pass the written test for a hazardous materials endorsement must be taken and
18		passed .
19	SEC	CTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06.2-09.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
20	amende	d and reenacted as follows:
21	39-0	06.2-09.1. Nonresident commercial license.
22	1.	The department may issue a nonresident commercial driver's license to an applicant
23		who does not present a social security card as required by section 39-06.2-08 but who
24		otherwise meets the requirements for a nonresident commercial driver's license. A
25		license issued under this subsection is valid only during the period of time of the
26		applicant's authorized stay in the United States. The license may be renewed only
27		upon presentation of valid documentary evidence that the status has been extended.
28		The department shall renew without a skills or knowledge test a nonresident
29		commercial license that has been expired for a duration not longer than one year.
30	2.	The fee for a nonresident commercial driver's license is twenty dollarslisted in section
31		<u>39-06.2-19</u> .

1	SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06.2-13.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is				
2	amended and reenacted as follows:				
3	39-06.2-13.1. Driving record information to be furnished.				
4	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the director shall furnish, and upon request and				
5	payment of a fee of three dollars<u>listed in section 39-06.2-19</u>, <u>the director shall provide</u> full				
6	information regarding the driving record of a personan individual who has been issued a				
7	commercial driver's license to an employer or to a prospective employer if the personindividual				
8	has given written consent to the prospective employer for this information.				
9	SECTION 6. Section 39-06.2-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted				
10	as follov	vs:
