- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-06.1-06 and subsection 2 of section
- 2 <u>40-05-06</u> of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to fees for speeding.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-06.1-06.** Amount of statutory fees.

- 7 The fees required for a noncriminal disposition pursuant to either section 39-06.1-02 or
- 8 39-06.1-03 must be as follows:
- For a nonmoving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-08, a fee of any amount not to
 exceed twenty dollars.
- 11 2. For a moving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-09, a fee of twenty dollars, except
 12 for:
- 13 a. A violation of section 39-10-26, 39-10-26.2, 39-10-41, 39-10-42, 39-10-46, or
 14 39-10-46.1, a fee of fifty dollars.
- b. A violation of section 39-10-05 involving failure to yield to a pedestrian or
 subsection 1 of section 39-10-28, a fee of fifty dollars.
- 17 c. A violation of section 39-21-41.2, a fee of twenty-five dollars.
- 18 d. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-12-02 or section 39-08-23, a fee of one
 19 hundred dollars.
- 20 e. A violation of subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 39-12-04, a fee of one
 21 hundred dollars.
- f. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-04-37 by an individual by becoming a
 resident of this state, a fee of one hundred dollars.

26		sixty-five miles [88.51104.61 kilometers] an hour, for a violation of section 39-09-02, or-	
27		an equivalent ordinance, a fee of twenty dollars in addition to the fee established as

16			out-of-service defects, two hundred fifty dollars;
17		C.	Operating a vehicle after driver placed out of service, operating a vehicle with ten
18			or more out-of-service defects, or operating a vehicle that has been placed out of
19			service prior to its repair, five hundred dollars; and
20		d.	All other violations of motor carrier safety rules adopted under subsection 3 of
21	I		section 39-21-46, fifty dollars.
22	11.<u>10.</u>	On	a highway on which the speed limit is posted in excess of sixty-five miles [104.61
23		kilor	neters] an hour, for a violation of section 39-09-02, or equivalent ordinance, a fee
24		of fi	ve dollars for each mile per hour over the limit.
25	12.<u>11.</u>	For	a violation of a school zone speed limit under subdivision b of subsection 1 of
26		sect	ion 39-09-02, or, notwithstanding subsection 2 of section 40-05-06 or section
27		40-0	05.1-06, of an ordinance in a city or home rule city for a violation of a speed limit
28		dep	endent upon being on or near a school, fees for a noncriminal disposition are

3	13.<u>12.</u>	For a violation of a highway construction zone speed limit under subsection 2 of
4		section 39-09-02, a fee of eighty dollars for one through ten miles per hour over the
5		posted speed; and eighty dollars plus two dollars for each mile per hour over ten miles
6		per hour over the limit, unless a greater fee would be applicable under this section.
7		The fee in this subsection does not apply to a highway construction zone unless
8		individuals engaged in construction are present at the time and place of the violation
9		and the posted speed limit sign states "Minimum Fee \$80".

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 40-05-06 of the North Dakota Century
Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
