- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for company police officers.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- 3 **SECTION 1**.
- 4 Company police officers.
- 5 To be qualified as a company police officer, an individual must be designated by a business,
- 6 be a licensed peace officer, and be approved by the sheriff in the county in which the officer
- 7 <u>engages in law enforcement activities. If qualified, a company police officer while engaged in </u>
- 8 employment with the business has the authority to enforce the law and conduct or engage in
- 9 <u>investigations or prosecutions for violations of the law occurring on the property of the business</u>
- or involving property of the business. A company police officer has the power to remove from
- 11 the property of the business an individual who does not have the right to be on the property or
- who is engaged in a conduct prohibited by title 12.1. Under this section, a business designating
- 13 <u>a company police officer must be engaged in an oil-related or gas-related business.</u>
