1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a program to provide autism spectrum disorder training and

2 <u>support and</u> for the establishment of an autism spectrum disorder registry; and to provide-

3 appropriations to the state department of health for an autism spectrum disorder registry, STEMI-

4 registry, stroke registry, and to the department of public instruction for autism spectrum disorder-

5 educational training and support.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1.

- 8 Autism spectrum disorder training and support.
- 9 The department of public instruction shall provide training and support to general education

10 classroom teachers and other school staff regarding the most effective methods of educating

11 and providing services and support to individuals with autism spectrum disorder.

12 SECTION 2.

13 Autism spectrum disorder registry - Required reporting.

14 <u>The state department of health shall establish and administer an autism spectrum disorder</u>

15 registry. The registry must include a record of all reported cases of autism spectrum disorder in

16 the state and any other information deemed relevant and appropriate by the department in

- 17 order to complete epidemiologic surveys of the autism spectrum disorder, enable analysis of the
- 18 <u>autism spectrum disorder, and provide services to individuals with an autism spectrum disorder.</u>

19 <u>A physician, psychologist, or any other licensed provider who is qualified by training to make the</u>

20 diagnosis and who then makes the diagnosis that a child is affected with autism spectrum

21 disorder shall report each new case of this diagnosis to the department in a form and manner

22 prescribed by the state health officer. The report must include the child's birth date, gender, zip

- 23 code at birth residence, and the specific diagnosis of the child diagnosed as having autism
- 24 spectrum disorder. The report may not include the name or address of the child. Nothing in this

1	section may be construed to compel a child who has been reported as affected with autism
2	spectrum disorder to submit to medical or health examination or supervision by the department.
3	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH - REGISTRY. There-
4	is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise
5	appropriated, the sum of \$148,132, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state
6	department of health for the purpose of establishing and administering an autism spectrum
7	disorder registry, STEMI registry, and stroke registry for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013,
8	and ending June 30, 2015. The state department of health is authorized one full-time equivalent
9	position for these initiatives.

11	SPECTRUM DISORDER EDUCATIONAL TRAINING AND SUPPORT. There is appropriated
12	out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum-
13	of \$198,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of public-
14	instruction for the purpose of providing training and support to general education classroom
15	teachers, other school staff, and parents regarding the most effective methods of educating and
16	providing services and support to individuals with autism spectrum disorder, for the biennium
17	beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.
