## **REENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1038**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a program to provide autism spectrum disorder training and
- 2 support and for the establishment of an autism spectrum disorder registry.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1.
- 5 <u>Autism spectrum disorder training and support.</u>
- The department of public instruction shall provide training and support to general education
- 7 classroom teachers and other school staff regarding the most effective methods of educating
- 8 and providing services and support to individuals with autism spectrum disorder.
- 9 **SECTION 2.**
- 10 Autism spectrum disorder registry Required reporting.
- 11 The state department of health shall establish and administer an autism spectrum disorder
- 12 registry. The registry must include a record of all reported cases of autism spectrum disorder in
- 13 the state and any other information deemed relevant and appropriate by the department in
- order to complete epidemiologic surveys of the autism spectrum disorder, enable analysis of the
- 15 autism spectrum disorder, and provide services to individuals with an autism spectrum disorder.
- 16 A physician, psychologist, or any other licensed provider who is qualified by training to make the
- diagnosis and who then makes the diagnosis that a child is affected with autism spectrum
- 18 <u>disorder shall report each new case of this diagnosis to the department in a form and manner</u>
- 19 prescribed by the state health officer. The report must include the child's birth date, gender, zip
- 20 code at birth residence, and the specific diagnosis of the child diagnosed as having autism
- 21 spectrum disorder. The report may not include the name or address of the child. Nothing in this
- 22 section may be construed to compel a child who has been reported as affected with autism
- 23 spectrum disorder to submit to medical or health examination or supervision by the department.
