- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for the establishment of a voucher system for autism spectrum
- 2 disorder services and support; and to provide an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1.
- 5 <u>Voucher system for autism spectrum disorder services and support.</u>
- The department of human services shall develop a voucher system for autism spectrum
- 7 <u>disorder services and support.</u>
- 8 <u>1.</u> The department shall implement a voucher program for individuals with an autism
- 9 spectrum disorder consisting of up to one hundred individuals up to age twenty-six and
- 10 up to fifty individuals aged twenty-six and older.
- 11 <u>2.</u> To be eligible for the voucher program, individuals must have been a resident of the
- 12 <u>state for a minimum of six months, have income levels that do not exceed three</u>
- hundred percent of the federal poverty level, and have a clinician's diagnosis of
- 14 autism, Asperger's syndrome, or pervasive developmental disorder not otherwise
- 15 specified.
- 16 3. Eligible services for individuals up to age twenty-six include assessments, medical
- care, mental health services, occupational therapy and equipment, speech and
- language services, assistive technology, case management, transportation,
- educational supports, respite care, executive and social skills training programs, and
- development and implementation of behavioral intervention plans.
- 21 <u>4. Eligible services for individuals aged twenty-six and older include assessments,</u>
- medical care, mental health services, occupational therapy and equipment,
- educational and employment services, housing, transportation, medical care, and
- 24 independent living services.

- 1 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
- 2 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$4,500,000, or so much of the
- 3 sum as may be necessary, to the department of human services for the purpose of
- 4 administering a voucher system for autism spectrum disorder services and support, for the
- 5 biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015. The department shall allocate up
- 6 to \$30,000 per year to each individual enrolled in the voucher program for paying costs of
- 7 eligible services.
