- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 23-12 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to participation in the health information organization.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 23-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

6 <u>Voluntary participation in the health information organization - Prohibition on</u>

7 withholding care or benefits.

- 8 <u>1.</u> <u>As used in this section:</u>
- 9a."Health information organization" means the health information exchange created10under chapter 54-59.
- b. <u>"Individually identifiable health information" has the meaning set forth in title 45,</u>
 <u>Code of Federal Regulations, section 160.103.</u>
- 13 <u>2.</u> <u>An individual may opt-out of participating in the health information organization by</u>
- 14 providing notice to the organization. If an individual chooses to opt-out of participating
- 15 in the health information organization, the individual's individually identifiable health
- 16 information may not be accessed by search by a health insurer, government health
- plan, or health care provider other than the provider who originally created or ordered
 the creation of the individually identifiable health information.
- 19 <u>3.</u> In opting out of participating in the health information organization under this section,
 20 <u>the individual must have the option of:</u>
- 21 <u>a.</u> Opting out of participating; or
- 22 b. Conditionally opting out, in which case the accessibility of the individual's

23 individually identifiable health information is limited to access by a health care

24 provider who determines access is required by a medical emergency.

3		<u>a.</u>	May be changed at any time by the individual by providing written notice to the
4			health information organization.
5		<u>b.</u>	Does not prohibit use or disclosure of individually identifiable health information

7	<u>5.</u>	A health care provider, health insurer, or government health plan may not withhold	
8		<u>cov</u>	erage or care from an individual nor may a health insurer deny an individual a
9		hea	Ith insurance benefit plan based solely on that individual's choice to participate or
10		<u>to c</u>	pt-out of the health information organization.
