- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 61-02 of the North Dakota-
- 2 Century Code, relating to allocation of funds from the resources trust fund by the state water-
- 3 commission.for an act to amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 57-51.1-07.1 of the North
- 4 Dakota Century Code, relating to the resources trust fund.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 61-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
 7 and enacted as follows:
- 8 <u>Allocation of funds from the resources trust fund.</u>
- 9 <u>The state water commission shall develop policies to maximize long-term funding for water</u>
- 10 development and water management through the resources trust fund. In furtherance of these
- 11 policies, the state water commission shall:
- 12 <u>1. Consider factors such as revenues, water rates, operation and maintenance costs,</u>
 13 <u>local assessments and contributions, and other local commitments.</u>
- <u>Allocate funds from the resources trust fund in the form of loans if an entity is</u>
 <u>determined to have the ability to repay the funds allocated.</u>
- <u>3. Set the terms of loans for entities that have the ability to repay funds allocated,</u>
 <u>including length of repayment, interest rates, and other terms.</u>
- 18 If the commission determines an entity does not have the ability to repay the funds allocated,
- 19 the commission may allocate funds in the form of grants up to the amount the entity has an-
- 20 inability to repay the funds allocated.
- 21 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of section 57-51.1-07.1 of the North Dakota
- 22 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- The state water commission shall adopt rules for governing the review and
 recommendation of proposed water projects for which financial assistance by

1	legislative appropriation from the resources trust fund is being sought under this
2	section. The rules must consider project revenues, local cost sharing, and ability to
3	pay. The rules may provide for repayment of a portion of funds allocated from the
4	resources trust fund.
