- 2 39-21-44.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to covering a load in a vehicle and fee
- 3 for a violation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 2 of section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota
- 6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 2. For a moving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-09, a fee of twenty dollars, except for:
- 9 a. A violation of section 39-10-26, 39-10-26.2, 39-10-41, 39-10-42, 39-10-46, or 39-10-46.1, a fee of fifty dollars.
- b. A violation of section 39-10-05 involving failure to yield to a pedestrian or
 subsection 1 of section 39-10-28, a fee of fifty dollars.
- 13 c. A violation of section 39-21-41.2, a fee of twenty-five dollars.
- d. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-12-02 or section 39-08-23, a fee of one hundred dollars.
- e. A violation of subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 39-12-04, a fee of one
 hundred dollars.
- f. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-04-37 by an individual by becoming a resident of this state, a fee of one hundred dollars.
- g. A violation of subsection 2 of section 39-10-21.1, a fee of two hundred fifty dollars.
- h. A violation of section 39-10-59, a fee of one hundred dollars.
- i. A violation of section 49-21-44.1 for not securely covering a load of sand or
 gravel, a fee of five hundred dollars.

individual many not operate a vehicle for hire with a load of sand or gravel without a secure

cover that keeps the load within or on the vehicle.
