- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 16.1-08.1-02, subsection 2 of
- 2 section 16.1-08.1-03, subsection 4 of section 16.1-08.1-03.1, subsection 3 of section

#### 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

11 The candidate committee, or candidate for statewide office who does not have a 3. 12 candidate committee, and any candidate for legislative office shall file the statement in 13 the office of the secretary of state no later than the twelfththirty-second day before the 14 date of the election in which the candidate's name appears on the ballot or in which 15 the candidate seeks election through write-in votes complete from the beginning of 16 that calendar year through the twentiethfortieth day before the date of the election. 17 Every candidate committee, or candidate for statewide office who does not have a 18 candidate committee, and every candidate for legislative office shall file a complete 19 statement for each calendar year no later than the thirty-first day of January of the 20 following year, regardless of whether the candidate sought election during that 21 calendar year.

  filing. The statement is to be considered a part of the public records of the
  secretary of state's office and must be open to public inspection.

If the filing date falls on a Saturday or Sunday or a holiday on which the office of the 5 secretary of state is closed, the statement must be filed on the next available day on 6 which the office of the secretary of state is open. In determining the amount of 7 individual contributions from any contributor, all amounts received from the same 8 contributor during the reporting period must be aggregated to report an overall total 9 contribution for the purposes of the statements required by this chapter. Aggregate 10 contributions must reference the date of the most recent contribution. Contributions 11 made separately by different persons from joint accounts are considered separate 12 contributions for reporting purposes.
- Before February 1, 2014, the secretary of state shall implement a system through
   which any statement required by this chapter to be filed with the secretary of state
   must be filed through an electronic filing application provided by the secretary of state.
- 16The system must be designed so that any statement and data filed electronically may17be made available on the internet to the public free of charge within twenty-four hours18after filing.
- Unless otherwise provided by law, any candidate, political party, committee, or person
   may not be charged a fee for filing any statement with the secretary of state under this
   chapter.
- 22 SECTION 12. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-08.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- amended and reenacted as follows:

## 24 **16.1-08.1-06.** Contributions and expenditure statement requirements.

- 25 1. Any statement required by this chapter to be filed with the secretary of state must be:
- 26a.Deemed properly filed when deposited with orelectronically delivered to the27secretary of state within the prescribed time and in the format established by the28secretary of state. A statement that is mailed is deemed properly filed when it is-29postmarked and directed to the secretary of state within the prescribed time. If30the secretary of state does not receive a statement, a duplicate of the statement31must be promptly filed upon notice by the secretary of state of its nonreceipt.

1 After a statement has been filed, the secretary of state may request or accept 2 written clarification along with an amended statement from a candidate, political 3 party, or political committee filing the statement when discrepancies, errors, or 4 omissions on the statement are discovered by the secretary of state, the 5 candidate, political party, or political committee filing the statement, or by any 6 interested party reciting a lawful reason for requesting clarification and an 7 amendment be made. When requesting an amended statement, the secretary of 8 state shall establish a reasonable period of time, not to exceed ten days, agreed 9 to by the candidate, political party, or political committee, for filing the amended 10 statement with the secretary of state.

- b. Preserved by the secretary of state for a period of fourten years from the date of
  filing. The statement is to be considered a part of the public records of the
  secretary of state's office and must be open to public inspection.
- 14 2. If the filing date falls on a Saturday or Sunday or a holiday on which the office of the 15 secretary of state is closed, the statement must be filed on the next available day on-16 which the office of the secretary of state is open. In determining the amount of 17 individual contributions from any contributor, all amounts received from the same 18 contributor during the reporting period must be aggregated to report an overall total 19 contribution for the purposes of the statements required by this chapter. Aggregate 20 contributions must reference the date of the most recent contribution. Contributions 21 made separately by different persons from joint accounts are considered separate 22 contributions for reporting purposes.
- Before February 1, 2014, the secretary of state shall implement a system through which any statement required by this chapter to be filed with the secretary of state must be filed through an electronic filing application provided by the secretary of state.
   The system must be designed so that anyAny statement and data filed electronically
   maymust be made available on the internet to the public free of charge within
   twenty-four hours after filing.
- Unless otherwise provided by law, any candidate, political party, committee, or person
   may not be charged a fee for filing any statement with the secretary of state under this
   chapter.
