A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-10-16 and subdivision c of subsection 1 of section 15-10-17 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the authority of the state board of higher education to transfer funds and to the hiring of North Dakota university system-employees for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the assessment of institutions of higher education; to provide an expiration date; and to declare an emergency.

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-10-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

amended and reenacted as follows: 15-10-16. Control of funds and appropriations of educational institutions. The state board of higher education has the control of the expenditure of the fundsbelonging and allocated to the institutions under its control and also of those appropriated by the legislative assembly for such institutions, but funds appropriated by the legislative assembly and specifically designated for any one or more of such institutions may not be used for any other institution. The state board of higher education may not use funds appropriated and specifically designated for any one institution for the support of the university system office or for the hiring or payment of personnel directly under the authority or supervision of the commissioner of higher education. SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subdivision c of subsection 1 of section 15-10-17 of the North-Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: Appoint and remove all university system office personnel, fix their salaries within the limits of legislative appropriations, fix their terms of office, and prescribe their duties. The salaries and expenses of any university system office personnel hiredby the board must be paid from appropriations specifically designated for the
