- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to patriotic logos on number plates; to amend and reenact sections
- 3 39-04-10.3 and 39-04-10.14 and subdivisions j and o of subsection 2 of section 39-04-18 of the

4 North Dakota Century Code, relating to number plates for certain veterans; and to provide an

5 appropriation.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-04-10.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is
8 amended and reenacted as follows:

9 **39-04-10.3.** Personalized plates.

10 TheAt the request of a registrant, the department may, in its discretion, provide special 11 license plates marked with not more than seven numerals, letters, or ampersands, or 12 combinations of numerals, letters, and ampersands, at the request of the registrant, upon 13 application therefor for a special license plate and payment of an additional fee of twenty-five 14 dollars per registration period, unless the plate is a gold star license plate or a prisoner of war 15 license plate, then there is no additional charge. The department shall make the special license 16 plates authorized by this section available for motor vehicles registered under section 17 39-04-10.6, trailers, travel trailers, and motorcycles. The fee for the special license plates issued 18 under this section for vehicles registered under section 39-04-10.6 is a one-time fee of one 19 hundred dollars. The special license plates for motorcycles may contain not more than six 20 numerals, letters, or ampersands, or a combination of not more than six numerals, letters, and 21 ampersands. In the event of sale or transfer of the vehicle, the owner must remove the special 22 license plates in accordance with section 39-04-36. Upon payment of the applicable transfer 23 fee, the special license plates may be transferred to a replacement motor vehicle.

1	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 39-04-10.14 of the North Dakota Century Code is						
2	amended and reenacted as follows:						
3	39-0	39-04-10.14. North Dakota gold star number plates - Definition - Description - Fee.					
4	1.	The director may issue distinctive number plates to a surviving spouse, parent,					
5		including stepmother, stepfather, parent through adoption, and foster parent who					
6		stands or stood in loco parentis, grandparents, child, including stepchild and child					
7		through adoption, and sibling, including half-brother and half-sister, of a member of the					
8		armed forces of the United States who died while serving on active duty during a time					
9		of military conflict. The director shall issue a number plate under this section upon					
10		receiving:					
11		a. Payment payment of all other fees required under this chapter for registration of a					
12		motor vehicle;					
13		b. Payment of an initial fee of fifteen dollars, of which ten dollars is to be deposited					
14		in the highway tax distribution fund and five dollars is to be deposited in the					
15		veterans' cemetery maintenance fund; and					
16		c. Verification of subsequent payments of an annual surcharge of ten dollars paid to-					
17		the adjutant general.					
18	2.	The department shall collect the fees and the ten dollar surcharge under this section.					
19		The department shall report to the legislative assembly on the funds collected under					
20		this section during each legislative session. The department shall pay the funds-					
21		collected for the veterans' cemetery and adjutant general to the adjutant general-					
22		monthly. Within ten days of receipt of the funds, the adjutant general shall deposit five-					
23		dollars of each initial fee in the veterans' cemetery maintenance fund and shall					
24		apportion the ten dollar surcharge and deposit five dollars in the veterans' cemetery					
25		trust fund and five dollars in the veterans' cemetery maintenance fund in the state					
26		treasury. The state treasurer may invest the fund in the same manner as the state					
27		investment board is authorized to make investments. At the request of the adjutant-					
28		general, the interest in the veterans' cemetery trust fund must be deposited in the					
29		veterans' cemetery maintenance fund for the purpose of funding salaries and					
30		maintenance of the veterans' cemetery.

2		the	plate and the letters "GS" before the number. The director shall cooperate with the
3		dire	ctor of the department of veterans' affairs to design the gold star emblem logo. The
4		dire	ctor may issue one set of plates per eligible owner of a passenger motor vehicle or
5		a tru	uck the registered gross weight of which does not exceed twenty thousand pounds
6		[907	71.85 kilograms].
7	<u>4.3.</u>	On	request of the director, the department of veterans' affairs shall certify those
8		sur∖	viving family members of deceased members of the United States armed forces
9		liste	d above as eligible to receive the plates.
10	5.<u>4.</u>	Onc	e declared eligible for a gold star plate, the department may not remove the
11		eligi	bility of a surviving family member.
12	6.<u>5.</u>	Onc	e a plate number is issued to an eligible family member, the department may not
13		assi	ign the plate to another eligible person.
14	SEC		3. AMENDMENT. Subdivisions j and o of subsection 2 of section 39-04-18 of the
15	North D	akota	Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:
16		j.	Motor vehicles not exceeding twenty-six thousand pounds [11793.40 kilograms]
17			registered gross weight owned and operated by a disabled veteran under the
18			provisions of Public Law 79-663 [38 U.S.C. 3901], a disabled veteran who has a
19			one hundred percent service-connected disability as determined by the
20			department of veterans' affairs, or a disabled veteran who has an extra-schedular
21			rating to include individual unemployability that brings the veteran's total disability
22			rating to one hundred percent as determined by the department of veterans'
23			affairs is entitled to display a distinctive license plate issued by the department
24			upon the payment of a fee of five dollars. This exemption applies to no more than
25			two such motor vehicles owned by a disabled veteran at any one time.
26		0.	Passenger motor vehicles, house cars, or pickup trucks not exceeding twenty
27			thousand pounds [9071.84 kilograms] registered gross weight owned and
28			operated by a resident who, while serving in the United States armed forces, was
29			a prisoner of war and has received an honorable discharge from the United
30			States armed forces; provided, however, thatvehicles is entitled to display a
31			distinctive license plate issued by the department upon the payment of five-

1			dollars. This exemption also applies to any passenger motor vehicle, house car,			
2			or pickup truck not exceeding twenty thousand pounds [9071.84 kilograms]			
3			registered gross weight subsequently purchased or acquired by such a former			
4			prisoner of war ; provided, that the. This exemption provided by this subdivision is-			
5			allowed only with respectapplies to oneno more than two motor vehiclevehicles			
6			owned by such a former prisoner of war at any one time. A surviving spouse of a			
7			former prisoner of war who has not remarried retains the exemption of the			
8			deceased veteran who qualified under this subdivision for one vehicle.			
9	SECTION 4. A new section to chapter 39-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created					
10	and enacted as follows:					
11	Patriotic logos.					
12	<u>1.</u>	The	e director shall issue four patriotic logos under this section upon receiving:			
13		<u>a.</u>	Payment of all other fees required under this chapter for registration of a motor			
14			vehicle;			
15		<u>b.</u>	Payment of an initial fee of twenty dollars of which the department shall deposit			
16			fifteen dollars in the highway tax distribution fund and pay five dollars to the state			
17			treasurer; and			
18		<u>C.</u>	Payment of an annual surcharge of ten dollars which the department shall pay to			
19			the state treasurer.			
20	<u>2.</u>	The	e department shall collect the initial fees and the annual surcharges under this			
21		<u>sec</u>	tion. During each legislative session, the department shall report to the legislative			
22		<u>ass</u>	embly on the funds collected under this section. For funds payable to the state			
23		<u>trea</u>	asurer under subdivisions b and c of subsection 1, the department shall pay the			
24		fune	ds monthly to the state treasurer, who within ten days of receipt of the funds, shall			
25		<u>dep</u>	osit five dollars of each initial fee and the annual surcharge in the veterans'			
26		pos	twar trust fund to be added to the principal of the fund. The state treasurer shall			
27		inve	est the fund in the same manner as the state investment board is authorized to			
28		mal	ke investments.			
29	SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general					
30	fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$9,000, or so much of the sum					
31	as may be necessary, to the department of transportation for the purpose of issuing patriotic

- 2 ending June 30, 2015.
- 3 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
 4 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$3,500, or so much of the sum
- 5 as may be necessary, to the adjutant general to be divided equally between the veterans'
- 6 cemetery trust fund and veterans' cemetery maintenance fund for the biennium beginning July
- 7 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.
