- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to nursing and basic care facility ratesetting; and to amend and reenact
- 3 section 50-24.4-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to allowable costs in nursing
- 4 home ratesetting.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 8 **Expedited ratesetting process Nursing and basic care facilities.**
- 9 The department shall establish an expedited ratesetting process by which nursing and basic
- 10 care facilities may request an increase in the established rate due to additional costs incurred
- by the facility for providing health insurance policies to the facility's employees, to the extent
- 12 those costs are directly related to the facility's compliance with the federal Patient Protection
- 13 and Affordable Care Act of 2010 [Pub. L. 111-148], as amended by the Health Care and
- 14 Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 [Pub. L. 111-152]. The process must provide that to be
- approved for a rate adjustment that is reflected in the facility's January 1, 2014, rates, the facility
- 16 must submit the adjustment request to the department by October 1, 2013.
- 17 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 50-24.4-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 18 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 19 50-24.4-06. Rate determination.
- The department shall determine prospective payment rates for resident care costs.
  The department shall develop procedures for determining operating cost payment
- 22 rates that take into account the mix of resident needs and other factors as determined
- 23 by the department.

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1 The department shall establish, by rule, limitations on compensation recognized in the 2 historical base for top management personnel. Compensation for top management 3 personnel must be categorized as a general and administrative cost and is subject to-4 any limits imposed on that cost category. 5 For purposes of determining rates, the department shall: 6 Include, contingent upon approval of the medicaid state plan by the centers for 7 medicare and medicaid services, allowable bad debt expenses in an amount not 8 to exceed one hundred eighty days of resident care per year or an aggregate of 9 three hundred sixty days of resident care for any one individual; and 10 Include allowable bad debt expenses in the property cost category in the report-11 year in which the bad debt is determined to be uncollectible with no likelihood of 12 future recovery. 13 Notwithstanding section 50-24.4-07, include as an allowable cost, any penalty 14 assessed under the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 15 [Pub. L. 111-148], as amended by the Health Care and Education Reconciliation 16 Act of 2010 [Pub. L. 111-152], to a nursing facility that does not offer health-17 insurance policies to its employees.
