- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact three new sections to chapter 19-03.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to controlled substance analogs; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** Three new sections to chapter 19-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code are

5 created and enacted as follows:

6 Controlled substance analog use - Penalty.

- 7 <u>1.</u> <u>A controlled substance analog is a substance with a chemical structure substantially</u>
- 8 similar to the chemical structure of a schedule I or II controlled substance or a
- 9 <u>substance that is used to affect the individual's central nervous system; to create or</u>
- 10 <u>induce a condition of intoxication, hallucination, or elation; or to distort, disturb or</u>
- 11 <u>change the individual's eyesight, thinking process, balance or coordination in</u>
- 12 <u>substantially similar manner as a schedule I or II controlled substance. An alcoholic</u>
- 13 <u>beverage is not a controlled substance analog.</u>
- 14 <u>2.</u> <u>The use of controlled substance analog includes the ingestion, inhalation, absorption,</u>
- 15 <u>or any other method of taking the controlled substance analog into the body. An</u>
- 16 individual who intentionally uses a controlled substance analog is guilty of a class C
- 17 <u>felony, unless the individual obtains the analog directly from a practitioner or pursuant</u>
- 18 <u>to a valid prescription or order of a practitioner.</u>
- 19 <u>3.</u> The venue for the violation exists in either the jurisdiction in which the substance was
 20 <u>used or in which the substance was detected.</u>
- 21 <u>Controlled substance analog possession Penalty.</u>
- 22 <u>A person that possesses a substance knowing that the substance is to be used as a</u>
- 23 controlled substance analog is guilty of a class C felony.
- 24 <u>Controlled substance analog manufacture or sale Penalty.</u>

- 1 <u>A person that manufactures, delivers, or possesses with intent to manufacture or deliver a</u>
- 2 <u>substance knowing that the substance is to be used as a controlled substance analog is guilty</u>
- 3 of a class B felony.
