- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the public service
- 2 commission; and to authorize a transfer.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the public service commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the public service commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, as follows:

8 Any 2013-15 one-time funding amounts included in this section are not a part of the entity's

9 base budget for the 2015-17 biennium. The public service commission shall report to the

appropriations committees of the sixty-fourth legislative assembly on the use of any one-time

11 funding items for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

SECTION 3. TRANSFER AND REPAYMENT - BEGINNING FARMER REVOLVING LOAN

FUND. The sum of \$900,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, included in the estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act, shall be transferred by the Bank of North Dakota from the beginning farmer revolving loan fund to the public service commission to pay for costs associated with a rail rate complaint case. Transfers shall be made during the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, upon order of the commission. If any amounts are spent pursuant to this section, the public service commission shall reimburse the beginning farmer revolving loan fund using amounts available from damages or proceeds received, net of legal fees, from a successful outcome of a rail complaint case.
