AMENDMENT. Section 24-02-37.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows: 7 24-02-37.2. Special road committee. 8 The special road committee consists of one member of the senate and one member of the 9 house of representatives legislative assembly appointed by the chairman of the legislative 10 management, the chairmen of the senate and house of representatives transportation 11 committees, the senate minority leader, the house minority leader, the director of the game and 12 fish department, the director of the parks and recreation department, and the director of the 13 department of transportation. If any member of the committee, except the director of the 14 department of transportation, is unable to attend a meeting of the committee, the member may 15 appoint a designee to serve in the member's place. The director of the department of 16 transportation is chairman of the committee. The committee must meet at the call of the director-17 to review requests for funding from the special road fund. The committee shall decide which-18 project requests will receive funding. The director shall provide staff services to the committee. 19 The members of the committee who are members of the legislative assembly are entitled to-20 compensation from the department of transportation, from moneys appropriated from the 21 special road fund, for attendance at committee meetings at the rate provided for members of
