1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 57-15 of the North Dakota 2 Century Code, relating to the authorization of a school district mill levy for an early childhood 3 education program; and to amend and reenact section 15.1-09-58 of the North Dakota Century 4 Code, relating to early childhood education. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-09-58 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows: 8 15.1-09-58. Prekindergarten programEarly childhood education - Authorization -9 Support. 10 The board of a school district may establish a prekindergartenan early childhood education 11 program and, provided the program is approved by the superintendent of public instruction in 12 accordance with chapter 15.1-37, may receive and expend any states upport that program with: 13 <u>1.</u> Local tax revenues, other than those necessary to support the district's kindergarten 14 program and the provision of elementary and high school educational services; 15 State moneys specifically appropriated for the program, any federal; <u>2.</u> 16 <u>3.</u> Federal funds specifically appropriated or approved for the program, and any gifts; and 17 Gifts, grants, and donations specifically given for the program. 18 SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 57-15 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 19 and enacted as follows: 20 Early childhood education program - Mill levy - Voter approval.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, upon approval by a majority of the

qualified electors of the school district voting on the question at a regular or special school

district election, the board of the district may dedicate a tax levy of one mill on each dollar of

taxable valuation of real property in the district for the purpose of establishing and supporting an

- 1 <u>early childhood education program. All revenue accruing from this levy must be deposited in a</u>
- 2 <u>separate fund known as the early childhood education program fund. If the need for the early</u>
- 3 <u>childhood education program fund terminates, the board shall order the termination of the levy</u>
- 4 and shall transfer any balance remaining in the fund to the general fund of the school district.
