- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 7 of section 54-03-20 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to travel reimbursement for members of the legislative assembly.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 7 of section 54-03-20 of the North Dakota Century 5 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 7. a. In addition, each member is entitled to receive during the term for which the member was elected, as compensation for the execution of public duties during the biennium, the sum of four hundred forty dollars a month, paid monthly.
 - Subject to the prohibition on engaging in political activity under section 39-01-05. b. each member who represents a legislative district that is larger than one thousand square miles [2589.99 square kilometers] is entitled to travel reimbursement at fifty percent of the rate provided for state employees for travel to any meeting or function within the member's legislative district or to a meeting or function that is outside the member's district but which is located within a county that includes at least a portion of that member's district. A member of the legislative assembly is entitled to reimbursement under this subdivision only if the meeting or function is located twenty miles [32.19 kilometers] or more from the member's residence. The reimbursement a member receives under this subdivision may not exceed two hundred dollars per year. In addition to submitting a signed voucher for the travel, to be eligible for reimbursement, the member shall submit a certification from an appropriately authorized individual who represents the entity that invited the member to participate in the meeting or function, attesting to the member's invitation to attend and the member's actual

attendance at the meeting or function.

- c. If a member dies or resigns from office during the member's term, the member may be paid only the allowances provided for in this section for the period for which the member was actually a member.
 - e.d. The majority and minority leaders of the house and senate and the chairman of the legislative management, if the chairman is not a majority or minority leader, are each entitled to receive as compensation, in addition to any other compensation or expense reimbursement provided by law, the sum of three hundred sixteen dollars per month during the biennium for their execution of public duties.
